Mr. Tang also holds a honourary title as the honourary chairman of GSST, a company incorporated in China whose shares are listed on the Shanghai Stock Exchange, in which the Company indirectly owns a 22.18% shareholding. Mr. Tang has been a Hong Kong Affairs Advisor to the Government of the People's Republic of China. He served as a member of the Standing Committee of the Chinese People's Political Consultative Conference and held a number of executive and advisory posts in some trade associations and public bodies over the last 50 years. Mr. Tang obtained a degree of Master of Science from the University of Illinois and a Honourary Doctorate degree in Social Science from the Chinese University of Hong Kong.
