"Jacquard" A special loom or the method employed in the weaving of

a figured fabric

"Oeko-Tex®" A certification for textile products issued by the

International Association for Research and Testing in the Field of Textile Ecology and a globally-recognised benchmark indicating that the product is environmentally

friendly and safe for its intended use

"point-of-sale terminals" The check-out system at our self-operated points of sale,

which generally include a computer, monitor, receipt printer and barcode scanner, providing sales and

inventory data
