

CHARACTERISTICS OF THE GROWTH ENTERPRISE MARKET ("GEM") OF THE STOCK EXCHANGE OF HONG KONG LIMITED (THE "STOCK EXCHANGE")

GEM has been established as a market designed to accommodate companies to which a high investment risk may be attached. In particular, companies may list on GEM with neither a track record of profitability nor any obligation to forecast future profitability. Furthermore, there may be risks arising out of the emerging nature of companies listed on GEM and the business sectors or countries in which the companies operate. Prospective investors should be aware of the potential risks of investing in such companies and should make the decision to invest only after due and careful consideration. The greater risk profile and other characteristics of GEM mean that it is a market more suited to professional and other sophisticated investors.

Given the emerging nature of companies listed on GEM, there is a risk that securities traded on GEM may be more susceptible to high market volatility than securities traded on the Main Board and no assurance is given that there will be a liquid market in the securities traded on GEM.

The principal means of information dissemination on GEM is publication on the internet website operated by the Stock Exchange. Listed companies are not generally required to issue paid announcements in gazetted newspapers. Accordingly, prospective investors should note that they need to have access to the GEM website in order to obtain up-to-date information on GEM-listed issuers.

This report, for which the directors (the "Directors") of Ningbo Yidong Electronic Company Limited (the "Company") collectively and individually accept full responsibility, includes particulars given in compliance with the Rules Governing the Listing of Securities on GEM of the Stock Exchange ("GEM Listing Rules") for the purpose of giving information with regard to the Company. The Directors, having made all reasonable enquiries, confirm that to the best of their knowledge and belief: (1) the information contained in this report is accurate and complete in all material respects and not misleading; (2) there are no other matters the omission of which would make any statement in this report misleading; and (3) all opinions expressed in this report have been arrived at after due and careful consideration and are founded on bases and assumptions that are fair and reasonable.

HIGHLIGHTS

Unaudited consolidated turnover was approximately RMB87,222,000 and RMB349,166,000 for the three and nine months ended 30 September 2007, representing an increase of approximately 50.3% and 56.4% when compared with the same period in 2006.

Unaudited (loss)/profit attributable to shareholders was approximately RMB2,227,000 (loss) and RMB1,419,000 (profit) for the three and nine months ended 30 September 2007, as contrast to profits in the corresponding period in 2006.

Unaudited (loss)/earnings per share was approximately RMB0.45 (loss per share) cents and RMB0.28 (earnings per share) cents for the three and nine months ended 30 September 2007.

RESULTS

The board of Directors of the Company (the "Board") is pleased to announce the unaudited consolidated results of the Company and its subsidiaries (the "Group") for the three and nine months ended 30 September 2007 together with the unaudited comparative figures for the corresponding periods in 2006 as follows:

Basis of preparation

The unaudited consolidated results of the Group have been prepared in accordance with Hong Kong Financial Reporting Standards ("HKFRS") and Hong Kong Accounting Standards ("HKAS") (collectively "HKFRSs"), accounting principles generally accepted in Hong Kong, the disclosure requirements of the Hong Kong Companies Ordinance and the Rules Governing the Listing of Securities on the GEM of the Stock Exchange (the "GEM Listing Rules").

The accounting policies adopted in preparing the unaudited consolidated results for the nine months ended 30 September 2007 are consistent with those followed in the preparation of the Group's annual financial statements for the year ended 31 December 2006.

The condensed consolidated results for the nine months ended 30 September 2007 are unaudited and have been reviewed by the audit committee of the Company.

Revenue

The Group is principally engaged in the design, manufacture and sale of controller systems for various consumer electrical and electronic appliances and the assembly of mobile phones in the PRC. Turnover is stated net of value added tax. Revenues recognised during the period under review are as follows:

The Group is subject to an income tax rate of 33% on its taxable profit in accordance with the income tax law in the PRC.

No provision for Hong Kong profits tax has been made as the Group has no estimated assessable Hong Kong profits for the period.

4. Earnings per share

(Lose)/Earnings per share is calculated based on the Group's (loss)/profit attributable to shareholders for the three and the nine months ended 30 September 2007 of approximately RMB2,227,000 (loss) and RMB1,419,000 (profit) (2006: profit RMB718,000 and RMB3,011,000) and 500,000,000 (2006: 500,000,000) shares in issue during the respective periods.

Diluted earnings per share has not been presented as the Company has no dilutive potential ordinary shares during the periods.

DIVIDEND

The Board does not recommend payment of interim dividend for the nine months ended 30 September 2007 (nine months ended 30 September 2006: interim dividend nil).

MANAGEMENT DISCUSSION AND ANALYSIS

Business review

During the period under review, the Group continued the manufacturing and selling of mobile phones, TV sets and various consumer electrical and electronic appliances, and achieved mild increases as compared to the corresponding period in 2006. As normal production capacity and marketing network were up-kept during low sales quarter of the year, the Group suffered loss during the third quarter consequently. The Group planned to recoup additional surpluses in peak seasons and tried to reduce deficit during low sales quarter in the future.

Financial review

Results

The Group recorded a turnover of approximately RMB349,166,000 for the nine months ended 30 September 2007, representing an increase of approximately 56.4%, as compared with the corresponding period in 2006 (2006: RMB223,295,000), and profit attributable to shareholders was approximately RMB1,419,000, representing a decrease of approximately 52.9%, as compared with the corresponding period in 2006 (2006: profit RMB3,011,000). The main reasons were due to both low gross margin ratios of the sales during the third quarter, and insufficient sales volume during low sales quarter for creating necessary gross sales margin in support of current production capacity and marketing network.

MANAGEMENT DISCUSSION AND ANALYSIS (continued)

Financial review (continued)

Gross profit

For the nine months ended 30 September 2007, the Group achieved an unaudited gross profit of approximately RMB44,406,000, representing an increase of approximately 19.8% over the previous period (2006: RMB37,056,000). The gross profit margin ratio decreased from 16.6% to 12.7%, representing a decrease of 23.4% as compared with the corresponding period in 2006; whilst counting the third quarter only, the gross profit margin ratio decrease from 19.8% to 10.4%, representing a decrease of 47.5% as compared with the corresponding period in 2006.

Prospect

The new plant was now planned to commence production in February 2008, and the move will match with expansion plan of the Group in 2008. With the plant investment, the Group can step in the mobile phone market with full forces, operates with no limitations and constraints in the next years at a minimum, and diversifies its product ranges immediately encountering emerged opportunities.

During the nine months ended 30 September 2007, none of the Directors, chief executive (if any) (the "Chief Executive") or supervisors of the Company (the "Supervisors") or their spouse or children under the age of 18 was granted any right to acquire shares of the Company or any of its associated corporation (as referred below), or had exercised any such right.

The Company has established an audit committee since 1 June 2003 with written terms of reference based on the guidelines recommended by the Hong Kong Institute of Certified Public Accountants and the requirements as set out in Rules 5.28 and 5.30 of the GEM Listing Rule. The audit committee comprises three independent non-executive Directors of the Company, namely Mr. Ding Gang Yi, who is the Chairman of such committee, Mr. Tang Zhen Ming and Mr. Ku Kin Shing.

The Audit Committee has reviewed with the senior management of the Company the accounting principles and practices adopted by the Group and discussed internal controls and financial reporting matters including a review of this quarterly financial statement for the nine months ended 30 September 2007.
