The Directors, having made all reasonable enquiries, confirm that, to the best of their knowledge and belief, the information contained in this report is accurate and complete in all material respects and not misleading or deceptive, and there are no other matters the omission of which would make any statement herein or this report misleading.

HIGHLIGHTS

- The Group recorded a turnover of approximately RMB19,338,000 for the three months ended 31st March, 2011, representing an approximately 6% decrease as compared with that of the corresponding period in 2010.
- The Group recorded a loss attributable to the owner of the parent of approximately RMB5,260,000 for the three months ended 31st March, 2011. Loss attributable to the owner of the parent for the corresponding period in 2010 was approximately RMB3,496,000.
- The Directors do not recommend the payment of an interim dividend for the three months ended 31st March, 2011.

FIRST QUARTERLY RESULTS

1. BASIS OF PRESENTATION

The Group's unaudited condensed consolidated results have been prepared in accordance with the new Hong Kong Financial Reporting Standards and Hong Kong Accounting Standards and interpretations issued by the Hong Kong Institute of Certified Public Accountants. The unaudited condensed consolidated results have been prepared on the historical cost basis. The accounting policies adopted in preparing the unaudited condensed consolidated results for the three months ended 31st March, 2011 are consistent with those followed in the preparation of the Group's annual financial statements for the year ended 31st December, 2010. The condensed consolidated results are unaudited but have been reviewed by the Company's audit committee.

2. TURNOVER

Turnover represents revenue from business solutions development, application software, network and data security products, and the sales and distribution of computers and electrical products and accessories. Turnover is stated net of valued added tax, other sales tax and returns. Revenue from provision of business solutions development, application software and network and data security products are recognised when delivery or acceptance has occurred, the fee is fixed and determinable, evidence of an arrangement exists, collection of the receivable is probable and no significant post-delivery obligations remain. Sales and distribution of computers and electrical products and accessories are recognised when goods are delivered and title has passed.

4. TAX EXPENSES

Pursuant to the Enterprise Income Tax Law of the People's Republic of China ("EIT") and its Implementation Regulations, the tax rate of the Company and its subsidiaries was 25% from 1st January, 2008 onwards.

For the three months ended 31st March, 2011, there was no material unprovided deferred tax (2010: nil).

5. LOSS PER SHARE

The calculation of the basic loss per share for the three months ended 31st March, 2011 is based on the unaudited loss attributable to the owner of the parent of approximately RMB5,260,000 (2010: loss attributable to the owner of the parent of approximately RMB3,496,000) and the weighted average number of shares during the period (three months ended 31st March, 2011: 480,000,000 shares; three months ended 31st March, 2010: 480,000,000 shares).

Diluted loss per share is not presented for the three months ended 31st March, 2011 and 2010 as there were no potential ordinary shares in issue during the relevant periods.

6. INTERIM DIVIDEND

The Directors do not recommend the payment of an interim dividend for the three months ended 31st March, 2011 (2010: Nil).

MANAGEMENT DISCUSSION AND ANALYSIS

FINANCIAL REVIEW

For the three months ended 31st March, 2011, the Group recorded a turnover of approximately RMB19,338,000, representing a decrease of approximately RMB1,134,000 or 6% (2010: approximately RMB20,472,000) as compared to corresponding period in 2010. The gross profit also recorded a decrease of approximately RMB 1,751,000 or 66% to approximately RMB919,000 for the quarter (2010: approximately RMB2,670,000). The Company continued to make loss for the first quarter 2011 and recorded a loss of approximately RMB5,260,000. The loss has increased by approximately RMB1,764,000 from approximately RMB 3,496,000 for the three months ended 31st March, 2010.

BUSINESS REVIEW AND FUTURE PROSPECTS

In the sales review, income is mainly generated from the sales and distribution of computer and electrical products and accessories. The sales volume has increased by RMB4,457,000 from RMB9,206,000 to RMB13,663,000, representing an increase of approximately 48%, mainly due to the recovery of economic environment and robust consumer market, leading to the increase of market demand

Besides, for the sales of business solutions development, its sales decreased from RMB11,172,000 to RMB3,652,000, representing a decrease of 67% over the corresponding period last year.

The sales of application software recorded significant increase from RMB94,000 of the corresponding period last year to RMB2,023,000. The increase in sales of this business was mainly due to various software products used and recognized by the clients.

In the expenses management and control, administration expenses amounted to RMB1,895,000, represented an increase of RMB111,000 over the corresponding period last year; and the expenses of marketing and sales amounted to RMB1,792,000, represented an increase of RMB482,000 over the corresponding period last year. However, the expenses of research and development amounted to RMB2,178,000, representing a decrease of RMB293,000 over the corresponding period last year.

In conclusion, the loss for the quarter was also attributable to the loss of the investments in the associates. The Company will take necessary proactive steps to monitor its financial condition and maintain its focus on cost control with the attempt to expand to new market areas, including acquiring new clients through the referrals by the existing clients and marketing initiatives by the management, so as to secure higher business volumes.

Shareholders of Jiaoda Industrial are Shanghai Jiao Tong University (96.735%) and Shanghai Jiaoda Enterprise Management Centre (3.265%), an entity wholly-owned by Shanghai Jiao Tong University. Both Jiaoda Industrial and Shanghai Jiao Tong University are deemed to be interested in the aggregate of 114,000,000 Domestic Shares held by Jiaoda S&T Park under the SFO.

These 60,000,000 Domestic Shares are registered and owned by Shanghai Xin Xuhui (Group) Limited, the registered capital of which will be owned as to approximately 74.58% by Xuhui District Industrial Association after the completion of certain capital reorganisation as referred to in the Prospectus. Xuhui District Industrial Association is deemed to be interested in the 60,000,000 Domestic Shares held by Shanghai Xin Xuhui (Group) Limited under the SFO.

AUDIT COMMITTEE

The Company established an audit committee (the "Audit Committee") on 7th July, 2002 with written terms of reference for the purpose of reviewing and supervising the Group's financial reporting and internal control procedures. The Audit Committee comprises three independent non-executive Directors, Mr. Yuan Shumin, Dr. Cao Guo Qi and Dr. Chan Yan Chong. The audit committee has reviewed the unaudited results of the Company for the three months ended 31st March, 2011.
