CHARACTERISTICS OF THE GROWTH ENTERPRISE MARKET (“GEM”) OF THE STOCK EXCHANGE OF HONG KONG LIMITED (THE “STOCK EXCHANGE”)

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This report, for which the directors (the “Directors”) of SHANGHAI JIAODA WITHUB INFORMATION INDUSTRIAL COMPANY LIMITED (the “Company”) collectively and individually accept full responsibility, includes particulars given in compliance with the Rules Governing the Listing of Securities on the Growth Enterprise Market of the Stock Exchange for the purpose of giving information with regard to the Company. The Directors, having made all reasonable enquiries, confirm that, to the best of their knowledge and belief, the information contained in this report is accurate and complete in all material respects and not misleading or deceptive, and there are no other matters the omission of which would make any statement herein or this report misleading.

HIGHLIGHTS

- The Group recorded a turnover of approximately RMB28,345,000 for the three months ended 31st March, 2014, representing an approximately 2.84% increase as compared with that of the corresponding period in 2013.
- The Group recorded a loss attributable to the owners of the parent of approximately RMB7,171,000 for the three months ended 31st March, 2014. Loss attributable to the owners of the parent for the corresponding period in 2013 was approximately RMB3,628,000.
- The Directors do not recommend the payment of an interim dividend for the three months ended 31st March, 2014.

FIRST QUARTERLY RESULTS

1. BASIS OF PRESENTATION

The Group's unaudited condensed consolidated results have been prepared in accordance with the new Hong Kong Financial Reporting Standards and Hong Kong Accounting Standards and interpretations issued by the Hong Kong Institute of Certified Public Accountants. The unaudited condensed consolidated results have been prepared on the historical cost basis. The accounting policies adopted in preparing the unaudited condensed consolidated results for the three months ended 31st March, 2014 are consistent with those followed in the preparation of the Group's annual financial statements for the year ended 31st December, 2013. The condensed consolidated results are unaudited but have been reviewed by the Company's audit committee.

2. TURNOVER

Turnover represents revenue from the development and provision of business application solutions, application software, the installation and maintenance of network and data security products, and the sales and distribution of computers and electrical products and accessories.

4. TAX EXPENSES

Pursuant to the Enterprise Income Tax Law of the People's Republic of China ("EIT") and its Implementation Regulations, the tax rate of the Company and its subsidiaries was 25% from 1st January, 2008 onwards.

For the three months ended 31st March, 2014, there was no material unprovided deferred tax (2013 : nil).

5. LOSS PER SHARE

The calculation of the basic loss per share for the three months ended 31st March, 2014 is based on the unaudited loss attributable to the owners of the parent of approximately RMB7,171,000 (2013: loss attributable to the owners of the parent of approximately RMB3,628,000) and the weighted average number of shares during the period (three months ended 31st March, 2014: 480,000,000 shares; three months ended 31st March, 2013: 480,000,000 shares).

Diluted loss per share is not presented for the three months ended 31st March, 2014 and 2013 as there were no potential ordinary shares in issue during the relevant periods.

6. INTERIM DIVIDEND

The Directors do not recommend the payment of an interim dividend for the three months ended 31st March, 2014 (2013 : Nil).

MANAGEMENT DISCUSSION AND ANALYSIS

FINANCIAL REVIEW

For the three months ended 31st March, 2014, the Group recorded a turnover of approximately RMB28,345,000, representing an increase of approximately RMB782,000 or 2.84% (2013: approximately RMB27,563,000) as compared to the corresponding period in 2013. The gross profit decreased approximately 203% to a negative amount of RMB982,000 as compared to the corresponding period in last year (2013: approximately RMB954,000). The Company continued to make loss for the first quarter of 2014 and recorded a loss of approximately RMB7,171,000. The loss has increased by approximately RMB3,543,000 as compared with approximately RMB3,628,000 for the three months ended 31st March, 2013.

BUSINESS REVIEW AND FUTURE PROSPECTS

In the sales review, income is mainly generated from the sales and distribution of computer and electrical products and accessories. The sales volume has increased from RMB18,261,000 to RMB25,169,000, representing an increase of RMB6,908,000 or approximately 37.83%, mainly due to the recovery of economic environment and robust consumer market, leading to the rise in market demand.

Besides, for the sales of business application solutions development, its sales reduced from RMB8,621,000 to RMB2,468,000, representing a decrease of 71.37% over the corresponding period last year.

The sales of application software recorded slightly increase from RMB216,000 of the corresponding period last year to RMB280,000.

For the expenses management and control, administration expenses amounted to RMB1,646,000, represented a decrease of RMB247,000 over the corresponding period last year; and the expenses of marketing and sales amounted to RMB1,872,000, represented a decrease of RMB134,000 over the corresponding period last year. The expenses of research and development amounted to RMB1,715,000, representing a substantial growth of RMB677,000 over the corresponding period last year.

In conclusion, the Company will take necessary proactive steps to monitor its financial condition. Meanwhile, it will also maintain its focus on cost control with the attempt to expand to new market areas, including acquiring new clients through the referrals by the existing clients and marketing initiatives by the management, so as to secure higher business volumes.

The substantial shareholder of Jiaoda S&T Park is Shanghai Jiaoda Industrial Investment Management (Group) Limited (“Jiaoda Industrial”) which owns 55.42% of registered capital in Jiaoda S&T Park. Shareholders of Jiaoda Industrial are Shanghai Jiao Tong University (96.735%) and Shanghai Jiaoda Enterprise Management Centre (3.265%), an entity wholly-owned by Shanghai Jiao Tong University. Both Jiaoda Industrial and Shanghai Jiao Tong University are deemed to be interested in the aggregate of 114,000,000 domestic shares held by Jiaoda S&T Park under the SFO.
3. These 60,000,000 domestic shares are registered and owned by Shanghai Xin Xuhui (Group) Limited, the registered capital of which will be owned as to approximately 74.58% by Xuhui District Industrial Association after the completion of certain capital reorganisation as referred to in the Prospectus. Xuhui District Industrial Association is deemed to be interested in the 60,000,000 domestic shares held by Shanghai Xin Xuhui (Group) Limited under the SFO.

The Company had adopted a code of conduct regarding securities transactions by the Directors on terms no less exacting than the Stock Exchange's required standard of dealings.

Having made specific enquiry of all Directors, the Company was not aware of any non-compliance with the Stock Exchange's required standard of dealings and its code of conduct regarding securities transactions by the Directors.

AUDIT COMMITTEE

The Company established an audit committee (the "Audit Committee") on 7th July, 2002 with written terms of reference for the purpose of reviewing and supervising the Group's financial reporting and internal control procedures. The Audit Committee comprises three independent non-executive Directors, Mr. Yuan Shumin, Dr. Cao Guo Qi and Dr. Chan Yan Chong. The Audit Committee has reviewed the unaudited results of the Company for the three months ended 31st March, 2014.

PURCHASE, SALE OR REDEMPTION OF SECURITIES
