# NOTES TO THE UNAUDITED CONDENSED CONSOLIDATED FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

#### 1 Corporate information

The Company is incorporated in the Cayman Islands as an exempted company with limited liability. The Company's shares have been listed on the GEM ("GEM") of The Stock Exchange of Hong Kong Limited (the "Stock Exchange").

The condensed consolidated financial statements are presented in Hong Kong Dollars ("HK\$"), which is same as the functional currency of the Company.

The principal activities of the Company and its subsidiaries (collectively referred to as the "Group") are engaged in the provision of securities, futures and options broking and trading, margin and loan financing services, placing and underwriting services, securities advisory service and investment holding.

### 2 Basis of preparation and principal accounting policies

The unaudited condensed consolidated results have been prepared in accordance with accounting principles generally accepted in Hong Kong, Hong Kong Accounting Standards and Hong Kong Financial Reporting Standards ("HKFRSs") issued by the Hong Kong Institute of Certified Public Accountants and the disclosure requirements of the GEM Listing Rules. They have been prepared on the historical cost basis except for certain financial instruments that are measured at fair value.

The accounting policies and method of computation used in preparing the unaudited condensed consolidated results are consistent with those used in the audited financial statements for the year ended 31 March 2018 except in relation to the new and revised standards, amendments and interpretations ("new and revised HKFRSs") issued by the Hong Kong Institute of Certified Public Accountants ("HKICPA") that are adopted for the first time for the current period's financial statements. The adoption of these new and revised HKFRSs has had no material impact on the unaudited condensed consolidated financial statements. The unaudited condensed consolidated quarterly results have not been reviewed by the Company's auditors, but have been reviewed by the Company's audit committee.

The Group has not early adopted any new HKFRSs that have been issued but are not yet effective.

# MANAGEMENT DISCUSSION AND ANALYSIS Market Review

During the reporting period under review, US stock market has well performance. Despite Trump's protectionist policies posing a threat to the US stock market, positive economic data and substantial corporate earnings growth arising from tax reforms have boosted the performance of US stock market. In Hong Kong stock market, the investors still concern about the impact of China-US trade war.

As the 30 June 2018, the Hang Seng Index recorded as 28,955 representing approximately 3.8% decrease as compared with 30,093 as at 31 March 2018.

#### **Business review**

The Group's revenue mainly included the income generated or derived from the securities business, interest income and the returns generated from the income rights. The Group's revenue for the three months ended 30 June 2018 was approximately HK\$11.4 million, as compared with the corresponding period in 2017 of approximately HK\$11.3 million, increased by approximately 0.1% or approximately HK\$0.1 million.

Securities and Futures Brokerage

Revenue from Securities and Futures Brokerage represent commission and brokerage fee and other fees including interest derived from cash and margin securities or futures accounts and interest from IPO financing.

The commission and brokerage fees on securities dealing increased by approximately 23.1% from approximately HK\$1.8 million for the three months ended 30 June 2017 to approximately HK\$2.2 million for the three months ended 30 June 2018. The total value of transactions for securities dealing increased by approximately 185.7% from approximately HK\$10,091.3 million for the three months ended 30 June 2017 to approximately HK\$28,831.6 million for the three months ended 30 June 2018.

Income relating to clearing and settlement fee and handling service increased by approximately 101.9% from HK\$342,819 for the three months ended 30 June 2017 to HK\$692,141 for the three months ended 30 June 2018.

The commission and brokerage fees on dealing in futures contracts increased by approximately HK\$148,756 from HK\$3,050 for the three months ended 30 June 2017 to HK\$151,806 for the three months ended 30 June 2018.

The interest income derived from cash and margin securities accounts for the three months ended 30 June 2018 was approximately HK\$2.7 million represents a decrease of approximately 11.1% from approximately HK\$3.0 million of the corresponding period in 2017.

#### Loan and Financing

The Group holds Money Lenders Licence under the Money Lenders Ordinance to engage in money lending business. CLC Finance Limited, the Company's wholly-owned subsidiary, provides loan and financing service to customers. As at 30 June 2018, CLC Finance Limited maintained the loan portfolio amounting to HK\$58.1 million. The interest income derived from providing loan and finance to customers for the three months ended 30 June 2018 was approximately HK\$5.0 million (2017: approximately HK\$3.9 million).

#### Securities Advisory Services

The Group holds licence under the Securities and Futures Ordinance to engage in Type 4 regulated activities — Advising on Securities. Revenue generated from this segment derived from services provided under these regulated activities.

#### Placing and Underwriting Business

Under normal circumstances, the Group acts as an underwriter or a sub-underwriter or a placing agent or a sub-placing agent on best effort basis for fund-raising activities. It would take the role on underwritten basis only if it received special requests from the issuers and/or their respective placing and underwriting agents.

The placing and underwriting commission decreased from HK\$70,000 for the three months ended 30 June 2017 to HK\$nil for three months ended 30 June 2018.

#### Investment Holding

The Group maintained a portfolio investments included the holding of listed equity securities, bonds and income right. The Group traded equity securities listed in Hong Kong and Canada. The Group holds an income right of the photovoltaic power plant at the rooftop of a factory located at Hunan Province, the PRC to generate stable cash inflow. As at 30 June 2018, the total value of the Group investment portfolio was approximately HK\$76.5 million (31 March 2018: approximately HK\$67.3 million), including the value of portfolio of listed securities of approximately HK\$40.5 million (31 March 2018: approximately HK\$38.6 million).

During the period under review, the Group received a return (net of PRC tax) of approximately HK\$609,398 (2017: approximately HK\$567,199) from an income right of the photovoltaic power plant at the rooftop of a factory located at Hunan Province, PRC.

During the period under review, net gain on trading of financial assets at fair value through profit or loss of approximately HK\$2.3 million (2017: approximately HK\$0.3 million), and the net gain in fair value of financial assets at fair value through profit of loss of approximately HK\$5.1 million (2017: net loss of approximately HK\$0.4 million).

#### Financial review

The Group's revenue for the three months ended 30 June 2018 was approximately HK\$11.4 million, representing an increase of approximately 1.3% from approximately HK\$11.3 million of the corresponding period in 2017.

Administrative expenses for the three months ended 30 June 2018 were approximately HK\$5.5 million (approximately HK\$5.5 million for the three months ended 30 June 2017), representing a decrease of approximately 0.3%.

Staff cost for the three months ended 30 June 2018 was approximately HK\$1.5 million (approximately HK\$2.0 million for the three months ended 30 June 2017).

Profit for the period attributable to owners of the Company amounted to approximately HK\$11.8 million for the three months ended 30 June 2018 (approximately HK\$4.9 million for the three months ended 30 June 2017). The increase in the profit for the period attributable to owners of the Company for the three months ended 30 June 2018 as compared with the corresponding period in 2017. Earnings per share attributable to owners of the Company was approximately HK0.53 cent for the three months ended 30 June 2018 (approximately HK0.22 cent for the three months ended 30 June 2017). Diluted earnings per share for the three months ended 30 June 2018 was approximately HK0.53 cent (2017: diluted earnings per share of approximately HK0.21 cent).

## Future plans for material investments or acquisition of capital assets

As at 30 June 2018, the Group had no plans for material investments or acquisition of capital assets, but will actively pursue opportunities for investments to enhance the profitability of the Group in its ordinary course of business.

#### **Outlook**

As the trade war intensified, global stock market will stay volatile. The US stock market are supported by earnings growth. And Hong Kong stock market is expected to hinder its performance in a short period. The Group will leverage the knowledge and experience of our management team to seize opportunities as they arise. The Group will continue to grow its brokerage business and placing and underwriting business by broadening clients base and by strengthening our trading platform. The Group will continue to put efforts on expanding the margin and loan financing business and securities advisory service and on satisfying the needs of our customers.

The Group aims to become a leading financial service group in Hong Kong. The Group will continue looking for any potential business opportunities to bring in new sources of income and to further increase the profitability of the Group.

#### **SHARE OPTIONS SCHEMES**

The Company has a share option scheme, namely, the share option scheme (the "Share Option Scheme") which was adopted on 22 February 2011.

#### **Share Option Scheme**

The Company adopted the Share Option Scheme on 22 February 2011, which was approved by the shareholders' written resolutions, is valid and effective for a period of 10 years, the remaining life of the Share Option Scheme is 3 years. It is established to attract and retain the best available personnel, to provide additional incentive to employees (full-time and part-time), directors, consultants, advisers, distributors, contractors, suppliers, agents, customers, business partners and service providers of the Group and to promote the success of the business of the Group. Pursuant to the Share Option Scheme, the Board may, at its discretion and on such terms as it may think fit, offer to grant an option to any employee (full-time or part-time), director, consultant or adviser of the Group, or any substantial shareholder of the Group, or any distributor, contractor, supplier, agent, customer, business partner or service provider of the Group. An offer for the grant of share options must be accepted within 7 days inclusive of the day on which such offer was made. The amount payable by the grantee of an option to the Company on acceptance of the offer for the grant of an option is HK\$1.

As at 30 June 2018, the total number of shares in respect of which share options may be granted under the Share Option Scheme is not permitted to exceed 110,000,000 shares, representing 5% of the total number of shares of the Company as at 30 June 2018.

Under the share option scheme, the Company may grant to directors (the "Directors") and employees of the Group and any other persons who, in the sole discretion of the Board, have contributed or will contribute to the Group which options granted shall be immediately vested. The maximum number of shares to be issued upon exercise of all outstanding options granted and yet to be exercised under the share option scheme and any other share option scheme of the Company must not in aggregate exceed 30% of the total number of shares in issue from time to time.

The total number of shares which may be issued upon exercise of all options to be granted under the share option scheme and any other share option scheme of the Company must not in aggregate exceed 10% of the shares in issue at the date of the passing of the relevant ordinary resolution. If any option is to be granted to connected person(s), it must be approved by independent non-executive directors or independent shareholders as the case may be.

The total number of shares issued and which may fall to be issued upon exercise of the options granted under the Share Option Scheme to eligible participants in any 12 months period up to the date of grant shall not exceed 1% of the Shares in issue as the date of grant. Any further grant of options in excess of this 1% limit shall be subject to the approval of shareholders in a general meeting.

The subscription price of a Share in respect of any particular option granted under the Share Option Scheme shall not be less than the highest of: (i) the closing price of the Shares as stated in the Stock Exchange's daily quotation sheets on the date of grant; (ii) the average of the closing prices of the Shares as stated in the Stock Exchange's daily quotation sheets for the five trading days immediately preceding the date of grant; or (iii) the nominal value of a Share.

The total number of shares in respect of which share options granted under the Share Option Scheme as at 30 June 2018 and not yet exercised was 100,000,000 which represented approximately 4.55% of the issued share capital of the Company as at 30 June 2018.
