# CHARACTERISTICS OF GEM OF THE STOCK EXCHANGE OF HONG KONG LIMITED (THE "STOCK EXCHANGE")

GEM has been positioned as a market designed to accommodate small and mid-sized companies to which a higher investment risk may be attached than other companies listed on the Stock Exchange. Prospective investors should be aware of the potential risks of investing in such companies and should make the decision to invest only after due and careful consideration.

Given that the companies listed on GEM are generally small and mid-sized companies, there is a risk that securities traded on GEM may be more susceptible to high market volatility than securities traded on the Main Board of the Stock Exchange and no assurance is given that there will be a liquid market in the securities traded on GEM.

# NOTES TO THE UNAUDITED CONDENSED CONSOLIDATED FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

# 1. GENERAL INFORMATION AND BASIS OF PRESENTATION

Orange Tour Cultural Holding Limited (the "**Company**", collectively with its subsidiaries, the "**Group**") was incorporated as an exempted company with limited liability in the Cayman Islands on 13 April 2018. The registered address of the Company is Sertus Chambers, Governors Square, Suite 5-204, 23 Lime Tree Bay Avenue, P.O. Box 2547, Grand Cayman, KY1-1104, Cayman Islands. The principal place of business of the Company is Composite Building, Xiazhang Village, Yicheng Subdistrict, Yixing City, Jiangsu Province, the People's Republic of China (the "**PRC**"). The Company's shares are listed on GEM of the Stock Exchange (the "**Listing**") since 14 November 2019 (the "**Listing Date**").

The Company is an investment holding company. The Group is principally engaged in the provision of event management services and design and production services.


## 2. BASIS OF PREPARATION AND PRINCIPAL ACCOUNTING POLICIES

The Group's unaudited condensed consolidated financial statements for the nine months ended 30 September 2022 have been prepared in accordance with the accounting principles generally accepted in Hong Kong and comply with Hong Kong Financial Reporting Standards ("**HKFRSs**") issued by the Hong Kong Institute of Certified Public Accountants ("**HKICPA**") and the applicable disclosure requirements of Chapter 18 of the GEM Listing Rules.

The accounting policies and methods of computation used in the preparation of the unaudited condensed consolidated financial statements for the nine months ended 30 September 2022 are consistent with those adopted in the Group's 2021 audited annual report dated 25 March 2022, except for the adoption of the new and revised Hong Kong Financial Reporting Standards (the "**New and Revised HKFRSs**") (which include all HKFRSs, Hong Kong Accounting Standards ("**HKASs**") and Interpretations) issued by the HKICPA that are adopted for the first time for the current periods financial statements.

The adoption of the New and Revised HKFRSs has had no significant effect on these unaudited condensed consolidated financial statements for the nine months ended 30 September 2022 and there have been no significant changes to the accounting policies applied in these unaudited condensed consolidated financial statements for the nine months ended 30 September 2022.

The Group has not applied new and revised standards, amendments or interpretations that have been issued but are not yet effective. The Group is currently assessing the impact of the adoption of such new and revised standards, amendments or interpretations to the Group but is yet to be in a position to state whether they would have any material financial impact on the Group's results of operations and financial position.



The unaudited condensed consolidated financial statements do not include all the information and disclosures required in the annual financial statements and should be read in conjunction with the Group's annual financial statements for the year ended 31 December 2021.

The unaudited condensed consolidated financial statements have not been audited by the Company's auditor, but have been reviewed by the audit committee of the Company (the "Audit Committee").

### 3. **REVENUE AND OTHER INCOME**

All revenue are recognised at a point in time. An analysis of the Group's revenue and other income for the three months and nine months ended 30 September 2022 are as follows:

No provision for Hong Kong Profits Tax has been made for the nine months ended 30 September 2022 and 2021 as the Group did not have any assessable profits arising in Hong Kong.

The Group has no material deferred tax not provided in the condensed consolidated financial statements as there were no material temporary differences at the end of the reporting period.

# MANAGEMENT DISCUSSION AND ANALYSIS

# **BUSINESS REVIEW AND OUTLOOK**

The Group is a marketing services company headquartered in Yixing of the PRC with a principal focus on the provision of (i) event management services; and (ii) design and production services. Commenced its business under its predecessor, the Group has accumulated over 15 years of experience in the provision of marketing services. Over the years, the Group has developed well-established relationships with customers from governmental and commercial sectors in the PRC.

The Group recorded a net loss of approximately RMB4.3 million for the nine months ended 30 September 2022 as compared with a net profit of approximately RMB1.4 million for the nine months ended 30 September 2021. The turnaround from net profit to net loss was primarily attributable to the decrease in revenue for the nine months ended 30 September 2022 as comparing with the same period in 2021, which resulted from the delayed and cancelled event managements projects during the period as negatively affected brought by the continued outbreak of the novel coronavirus (COVID-19) epidemic (the "**Epidemic**") and strict disease control measures in the PRC.

The core business of the Group continued to be severely negatively affected since the initial outbreak of the Epidemic in 2020. The market conditions continued to be very challenging due to the prolonged and volatile Epidemic situation especially in Yangtze River Delta such as Shanghai, Nanjing, Suzhou, Wuxi and Yixing since the outbreak in Shanghai as brought by Omicron variant in the first quarter of this year.

The ongoing Epidemic crisis continued impose a great challenge to the business environment which resulted in substantial economic and social disruption across Yangtze River Delta and slowing down the economic recovery with waves of the Epidemic.

Most importantly, the Epidemic related restrictions discourage our client to spend their budgets in the marketing and promotion activities. Even though the guarantine policy seems to be eased recently, different kind of unpredictable restrictions might continue affect our clients to execute their business plans. As our clients continued to remain cautious in managing under such situation and operate with a reduced budget and spending, the demand of the marketing services has been decreased throughout the year. One of the Group's business strategies was focused on marketing and promotion activities related to arts, cultural, festivals, tourism, However, the implementation was negatively affected by strict disease control measures, leading to a significant decrease in revenue as generated from these marketing and promotion activities. Moreover, the various level of community and travel guarantine in Wuxi and Yixing affect our key client such as government authorities, state-owned enterprises, real estate corporations and other corporate customers to delay or even cancel their marketing plans and reduce their marketing spendings under such situation. The declining number of event management projects undertaken and city-wide lockdown COVID-19 control measures with the decision to maintain a strict policy by the government authorities inevitably posed pressure on the revenue and results of the Group during the period.

#### **FINANCIAL REVIEW**

#### Revenue

The Group's revenue decreased by approximately RMB8.9 million, or 41.3%, from approximately RMB21.6 million for the nine months ended 30 September 2021 to approximately RMB12.7 million for the nine months ended 30 September 2022. Such decrease was mainly due to the decrease in number of projects undertaken for the event management services and design and production services during the period of comparison.

#### **Project costs**

The Group's project costs decreased by approximately RMB3.3 million, or 37.9%, from approximately RMB8.7 million for the nine months ended 30 September 2021 to approximately RMB5.4 million for the nine months ended 30 September 2022, which was in line with the decrease in revenue for the respective period.

# Employee benefits expense

The Group's employee benefit expenses increased by approximately RMB1.2 million from approximately RMB7.9 million for the nine months ended 30 September 2021 to approximately RMB9.1 million for the nine months ended 30 September 2022 as a result of the increase in the number of headcounts during the period of comparison.

#### Other operating expenses

It mainly represents the general office expenses, marketing and promotional fee and legal and professional fee. The Group's other operating expenses remained relatively stable at approximately RMB2.3 million and RMB1.9 million for the nine months ended 30 September 2021 and 2022, respectively.

# (Loss)/profit for the period

As a result of the foregoing, the Group recorded a net loss of approximately RMB4.3 million for the nine months ended 30 September 2022 as compared with a net profit of approximately RMB1.4 million for the nine months ended 30 September 2021.

# Dividend

The Board does not recommend the payment of any dividend for the nine months ended 30 September 2022 (2021: Nil).

The Audit Committee was established on 21 October 2019. The chairman of the Audit Committee is Mr. Ho Yau Kwok, the independent non-executive Director, and other members included Mr. Yip Koon Shing and Mr. Wong Kin Yip, the independent non-executive Directors. The written terms of reference of the Audit Committee are posted on the website of the Stock Exchange and on the Company's website.

The Company has complied with Rule 5.28 of the GEM Listing Rules in that at least one of the members of the Audit Committee (which must comprise a minimum of three members and must be chaired by an independent non-executive director) is an independent non-executive Director who possesses appropriate professional qualifications or accounting related financial management expertise.

The primary duties of the Audit Committee are to review the financial information and reporting process, internal control procedures and risk management system, audit plan and relationship with external auditors and arrangements to enable employees of the Company to raise, in confidence, concerns about possible improprieties in financial reporting, internal control or other matters of the Company.

The Audit Committee has reviewed with management of the Company on the accounting principles and practices adopted by the Group, this report and the third quarterly results announcement of the Group for the nine months ended 30 September 2022. The consolidated financial results for the nine months ended 30 September 2022 are unaudited, but have been reviewed by the Audit Committee. Such results comply with the applicable accounting standards, the requirements under the GEM Listing Rules and other applicable legal requirements, and that adequate disclosures have been made.
