DIRECTORS

Executive Directors:

Mr. TSOI Hon Chung, aged 50, is the Chairman of the Company and a co-founder of the Group. He is responsible for the overall management and formulation of corporate policies and strategy. He is also responsible for the business development of the Group, and liaising with various local government authorities in the PRC. He has over 15 years' operational and management experience in the textile industries in Hong Kong and the PRC. He is also a member of Chaoyang City Association of Foreign Investment Enterprises, the PRC and a council member of Shantou Economic Society, the PRC.

Mr. CAI Han Peng, aged 36, is the Deputy Chairman and a co-founder of the Group. He is responsible for the day-to-day operations in respect of production, devising marketing strategy and overall management of sales activities. Mr. CHEUNG Chun Ying, aged 39, is responsible for the overall accounting and financial management of the Group. Senior Management:
