

Biographical Details of Directors and Management

Executive Directors

Ms. Chiu Kam Hing, Kathy, aged 52, is the Chairman of the Company. Ms. Chiu has over twenty nine years of banking experience in Canada and the Asia Pacific Region. Ms. Chiu was senior vice president at the Republic National Bank of New York for thirteen years and was responsible for the management and investment of third party clients' funds. She served as a member of the board of trustees of the Lord Wilson Heritage Trust and the Sir Edward Youde Memorial Fund, as a member of the Sir Robert Black Trust Fund Committee and the Joint Committee on Student Finance and as an ex-officio member of the Gratham Scholarships Fund Committee. Ms. Chiu is active in community services and was appointed by the Government of Hong Kong to serve as a member to the Deportation Tribunal, the Solicitors Disciplinary Tribunal Panel, the Regional Advisory Committee for Hong Kong Hospital Authority and the Education Commission and as an adjudicator of the Immigration Tribunal and the Obscene Articles Tribunal. She was the former Chairman of Po Leung Kuk and a committee member of the Jackie Chan Foundation. Ms. Chiu graduated in Canada with a Bachelor degree in Business Administration. She is an associate and a fellow of the Institute of Canadian Bankers. She was appointed as a Justice of Peace in 1992 and as Cavaliere by the Italian Government in 1999. She is an independent non-executive director of Qianlong Technology International Holdings Limited, whose shares are listed on the Growth Enterprise Market of the Stock Exchange.

Mr. Pong Po Lam, aged 44, a graduate of Chinese University of Hong Kong with a B.Sc. and a MBA degree. Mr. Pong was formerly a director of Gartmore Fund Managers (Far East) Ltd and has worked for Jardine Matheson & Co. Ltd. from 1994 to 1995, Mr. Pong was previously the fund advisor of Guangdong Overseas Chinese Trust & Investment Corporation in China. In 1999, he was appointed as the director of Bank of East Asia (Trustee) Limited. In 1996, he was appointed as the director of Agri-AM Securities Investment Trust Corporation, a company owned by the largest bank group in Europe (in 1997) - Credit Agricole, the fund management company in France - BGP and Taiwan's financial institution with a capital of NT\$300 million. In 1997, the three funds under the company's name managed assets worth around NT\$10 billion. From 1992 to 1998, Mr. Pong was the managing director of Pegasus Lipper Analytical Services Limited which

was a joint venture between the Wall Street's famous fund analytical company. He is also the chairman of Chinese International Investment Institute Limited since 1992. In 2000, Mr. Pong was appointed by Hong Kong Science and Technology Parks as a Member of the Business Support and Development Division, and appointed as member of the advisory board of Finance Students' Society - Hong Kong University of Science and Technology. He also joined The Hong Kong Institute of Directors as Fellow in 2000. Appointed by the Hong Kong Federation of Business Students, he was one of the adjudicators for the Business Paper of the Year 2000. Mr. Pong was appointed by Prime Investments Holdings Limited, a company listed on the Stock Exchange as an executive director in 2001. Mr. Pong is also the founding member of The Institute of Financial Planners of Hong Kong which was established in 2001. Mr. Pong is a regular contributor on financial/investment issue to the Taiwan Economic Daily News, Hong Kong Economic Journal, Capital Magazine and author of a number of books on investment. He is always willing to provide training to fund industry professionals and is an instructor of the Hong Kong Securities Institute. In 2001, he was invited by the University of Hong Kong to join the Vice President of Moody's to hold seminars in Hong Kong, Macau and Shanghai for the Space Executive Programme, to assess the Sovereign & Corporate Credit Risk in Greater China. Mr. Pong has made many financial comments as to when and where to invest in many occasions and in many leading newspapers, TV and radio programs in the Asia region and is a regular guest speaker of RTHK and FM Select.

Ms. Pansy Ho Chiu King, aged 39, currently is the managing director of Shun Tak Holdings Limited, the chief executive officer and director of Melco International Development Limited and Shun Tak - China Travel Shipping Investments Limited, and executive director of Air Macau Company Limited. She is also a member of the Eighth Political and Consultative Committee of Guangdong Province and deputy chairman of the Third Guangdong Chamber of Foreign Investors, and founding honorary advisor of the University of Hong Kong Foundation for Education Development & Research and advisory council member of the Better Hong Kong Foundation.

Ms. Ho holds a Bachelor degree in Marketing and International Business Management from the University of Santa Clara.

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Non-Executive Directors

Mr. Lau Sak Hong, aged 53, is the chairman and managing director of Starlight International Holdings Limited, a company listed on the Stock Exchange and which he founded in 1969. Starlight International Holdings Limited is also the holding company of Cosmo Communication Corporation which is listed on NASDAQ and which is a major importing, marketing and distribution company of consumer electronics products in North America. Dr. Chan Po Fun, Peter, M.B.E., J.P., D.S. Ph.D., aged 79, is a certified public accountant. He has been honoured with awards by different governments, which include Cavaliere di Gran Croce of Italy, O.B.E. of Great Britain, Chevalier Legion d'Honneur of France, Commandeur de l'Ordre de Leopold II of Belgium and Gold Bauhinia Star of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region Government of the People's Republic of China in 1999. Dr. Lee has over 40 years of experience in business management.

Dr. Cheung Wai Bun, Charles, J.P., aged 65, is the group chief executive and executive deputy chairman of Mission Hills Group, Hong Kong. He holds an Honorary Doctorate degree in Business Administration, a Master degree in Business Administration and a Bachelor degree of Science. Dr. Cheung has more than thirty seven years working experience and he has held senior management positions in various industries including banking, finance, property, hotel development, management and investments.
