EXECUTIVE DIRECTORS

Ms. LO Yuk Yee, aged 42, is the Chairman and Managing Director of the Group and is responsible for the strategic planning and business development of the Group. Ms. Lo has been investing in cutting-edge technology and venture capital in the past six years and has been actively engaged in promoting commercialisation of biotechnology in the PRC and Hong Kong. In addition, Ms. Lo has been investing in early stage biotechnology projects in the United States of America and the PRC since 1999. Ms. Lo has extensive experience in finance, entrepreneurship and venture capital investments.

Mr. LOK Fai, aged 49, is the Deputy Chairman of the Group, mainly responsible for Apollo's overall strategy and business development. Mr. Lok is a pharmaceutical engineer and had been the honorary lecturer at the Shandong University in the PRC. He has been the Chairman and Managing Director of Guangdong Apollo (Group) Co.
