

Norwegian Sky (to be renamed Pride of Aloha) will commence inter-island Hawaiian cruises in July 2004.
























Founded in 1992, the award winning cruise line currently operates a single cruise ship, the Marco Polo specialising in destination—oriented cruises worldwide.
