DR CHENG KAR-SHUN, HENRY GBS

CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER MR WONG CHI-CHIU, ALBERT

Mr Wong (48) was appointed Executive Director in 2003 and subsequently Chief Executive Officer of the Company in March 2004. He is also the Managing Director of New World Telecommunications Limited and a Director of New World Telephone Holdings Limited.
