Executive Directors

Mr. Koo Cheng Yun, Leslie

Mr. Koo, aged 50, is the Chairman of the Company. He became a director of Hong Kong Cement Manufacturing Company Limited ("HKCM") (which carried on the Group's cement business in Hong Kong prior to the Group's re-organisation in September 1997) in July 1991. He is also the vice-chairman of Quon Hing Concrete Company Limited ("Quon Hing") and director of Hong Kong Concrete Company Limited ("Hong Kong Concrete"), both being associated companies of the Company. Mr. Koo is responsible for the overall policy and direction of the Group. He holds a bachelor's degree in business administration from the University of Washington and a master's degree in business administration from the Wharton School of the University of Pennsylvania, both in the USA. He is currently the chairman and president of Taiwan Cement Corporation ("TCC"), the ultimate holding company of the Company, a director of Taiwan Stock Exchange Corporation and the managing director of China Synthetic Rubber Co., Ltd., all in Taiwan, the chairman of Synpac Pharmaceuticals Limited, the United Kingdom, and the Chairman of Continental Carbon Company, the USA.

Mr. Wu Yih Chin

Mr. Wu, aged 50, is the Managing Director of the Company, the deputy managing director of Hong Kong Concrete and a director of Quon Hing and Yargoon Company Limited. He joined the Group in November 1993. Mr. Wu is responsible for overall management, strategic planning and business development for the Group. He holds a bachelor's degree in business administration form National Cheng Chi University, Taiwan, and a master's degree in business administration from the Wharton School of the University of Pennsylvania, the USA. He has more than 20 years of experience in cement-related businesses.

Non-executive Directors

Mr. Hui-Bon-Hoa Khien Piau, Pierre

Mr. Hui-Bon-Hoa, aged 84, became a director of HKCM in March 1977. He holds a master's degree in law from the University of Paris, France. He has over 40 years of managerial experience in a wide range of businesses including import and export, land development, automobile manufacturing and trading.

Mr. Hsiao Yin-Yi

Mr. Hsiao, aged 47, started his career with the Investing Banking Group of Citibank N.A., Taipei, Branch, after obtaining a bachelor's degree in statistics from the National Chung Hsin University of Taiwan. After his 13year career in Citibank, he joined The Silitek Technology Corporation, the biggest image product producer in Taiwan. From March 1998 to November 2002, Mr. Hsiao was the chief financial officer of The Silitek Technology Corporation. He is currently the chief financial officer of Taiwan Cement Corporation ("TCC") and a director of various subsidiaries of TCC.

Mr. Liao Poon Huai, Donald C.B.E., J.P.

Mr. Liao, aged 75, has been an independent non-executive director of the Company since August 1997. He was educated at the University of Hong Kong and the Univesity of Durham, the United Kingdom. He is a senior advisor to Mitsui & Co (HK) Limited. He retired from the Hong Kong civil service in 1989 and was the former Secretary for District Administration and the Secretary for Home Affairs. Mr. Liao was also appointed as an Official Member of the Hong Kong Legislative Council in 1980 and of the Hong Kong Executive Council in 1985.
