

DIRECTORS AND SENIOR MANAGEMENT PROFILE

EXECUTIVE DIRECTORS

Mr. CHENG Chi Tai, aged 61, Chairman of the Company. Mr. Cheng has been in the knitwear business since the 1960's and is the founder of the Group. Mr. Cheng is responsible for strategic planning and formulating the Group's overall business development strategy and corporate policies.

Mr. CHENG Kwai Chun, John, aged 33, is the Deputy Chairman and Managing Director of the Company and a son of Mr. Cheng Chi Tai. Mr. Cheng obtained a Bachelor degree in Science from the University of New South Wales, Australia, and a Master degree in Finance from the RMIT University, Australia. Mr. Cheng was also awarded the "Professional Diploma in Corporate Governance and Directorship" by Hong Kong Productivity Council and The Hong Kong Institute of Directors and a diploma in business management by the Hong Kong Management Association. Mr. Cheng joined the group in 1996 and is responsible for business development and overall day-to-day management and operations of the Group.

Mr. LIN Chick Kwan, aged 46, is a cousin of Mr. Cheng Chi Tai and a brother of Mr. Lin Chik Wai (who is a member of the senior management). Mr. Lin is responsible for the production operations of the Group in the PRC, Thailand and Hong Kong. He joined the Group in 1980 and had over 20 years of experience in knitwear and garment manufacturing, and particularly in hand-knitted garments.

Mr. LIN Wing Chau, aged 48, joined the Group in 1977. Mr. Lin is a cousin of Mr. Cheng Chi Tai and is responsible for the sales and distribution operations of the Group. He has over 20 years of experience in knitwear and garment manufacturing business.

Ms. KO Hay Yin, Karen, aged 52, has been the director of Kaiban Limited since 1990, a management consultancy practice in Hong Kong. Ms. Ko was previously the chief executive officer and an executive director of Goldwiz Holdings Limited (formerly known as Hong Kong Toy Centre International Limited) whose shares are listed on The Stock Exchange of Hong Kong Limited. Ms. Ko has been in the toy manufacturing industries for over 20 years. She graduated from The Hong Kong Polytechnic University (formerly known as The Hong Kong Polytechnic) in 1975 and obtained a Master degree in Business Administration in 1987 from The University of Macau (formerly known as The University of East Asia).

SENIOR MANAGEMENT

Mr. CHAN Chiu Hung, Alex, aged 39, is the qualified accountant and the financial controller of the Group. Mr. Chan is responsible for the Group's accounting, finance, taxation, investment and corporate governance. Before joining the Group in July 2003, he worked with a listed company and several other multinational companies for over 10 years.
