As the heart of a dynamic city, Causeway Bay has constantly reinvented itself. Always at the forefront of

progress, the area was the site of one of Hong Kong's earliest land reclamations. Not content with hosting the city's first tram line in 1923, Causeway Bay today is a superb traffic hub. Also with roots stretching back to probably the territory's earliest motion picture studio in Ngan Mok Street, Causeway Bay is Hong Kong's best known shopping and leisure destination, with a reputation enhanced by being the site of the city's first Japanese department stores and quality hotels like the Lee Gardens in the intervening years.
