

Major Events of the Year 2006

JANUARY

- The completion ceremony of a New Infectious Disease Centre at Princess Margaret Hospital was held. The 17-Storey Centre was built with reference to the WHO's standard and was the first in Hong Kong.
- To celebrate the 2006 Chinese New Year, the annual dinner was held at the Hong Kong Convention and Exhibition Centre with over 1,400 staff participated.

FEBRUARY

- The 2006 Chinese New Year media luncheon was held at the Club House of Hong Kong Jockey Club in Happy Valley. Over 30 media organizations joined the gathering.

APRIL

- The Group won various Considerate Contractors Site Awards for the Hong Kong construction industry which recognised the Group's achievements on environmental protection.
- The Group had undertaken the Design and Construction of a Sports Ground at Area 45, Tseung Kwan O. The contract was officially signed at the Headquarters of Architectural Services Department. The Sports Ground will be the main venue for East Asian Games 2009.

JULY

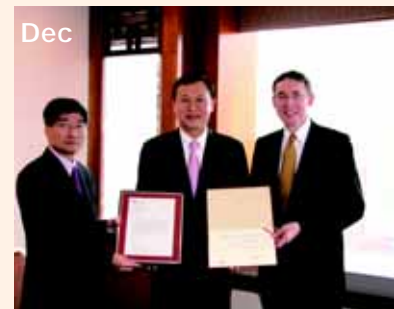
