

主席報告書 Chairman's Statement

財政業績

本人謹此宣布本集團截至二零零九年三月, 三十一日止年度之經審核業績。於本年度, 本集團之經營虧損為港幣210,000,000元, 而上一財政年度則錄得經營溢利港幣 448,300,000元。該虧損主要是投資物業估值 損港幣180,900,000元所致,而上一財政年度則 錄得投資物業估值盈利港幣455,000,000元。這 估值虧損只會影響本集團在會計上的溢過 虧損,而不會對其現金流量造成影響。倘假投 物業估值虧損不被計算在內,截至二零零虧損 約業時值虧損不被計算在內,截至二零零虧的 三月三十一日止財政年度,本集團之經營虧的 約為港幣29,100,000元,而上一財政年度的息 收入鋭減及於本年度支付國際廣場的廣告宣傳 及市場推廣費用所致。

業務回顧及財政業績之評論

截至二零零九年三月三十一日止財政年度,本集團之高爾夫球康樂會— Austin Hills Golf Resort 的分部虧損為港幣6,000,000元。該年度之分部收入為港幣17,300,000元,較上一財政年度下跌約港幣2,100,000元。

本集團的利息收入為港幣10,500,000元,較上一財政年度減少約港幣12,100,000元。利息收入鋭減主要是利率下跌所致。

Financial Results

I would like to report the audited results of the Group for the year ended 31 March 2009. During the year, the Group recorded a loss from operations of HK\$210.0 million, compared with a profit from operations of HK\$448.3 million for the previous financial year. The loss was mainly attributable to the valuation losses on investment properties of HK\$180.9 million, compared with the valuation gains on investment properties of HK\$455.0 million in the previous financial year. Such valuation losses will only affect the accounting profit or loss but not the cash flow of the Group. Excluding the valuation losses on investment properties, the Group recorded a loss from operations for the financial year ended 31 March 2009 of approximately HK\$29.1 million as compared with the loss from operations of approximately HK\$6.8 million in the previous financial year. It was mainly due to a steep reduction in interest income plus advertising and marketing expenses incurred for iSQUARE during the year.

Business Review and Commentary on Financial Results

Austin Hills Golf Resort, the Group's golf and recreational club operation, suffered a segment loss of HK\$6.0 million for the financial year ended 31 March 2009. Segment revenue for the said year was HK\$17.3 million, representing a decrease of approximately HK\$2.1 million compared with the previous financial year.

Interest income amounted to HK\$10.5 million, representing a decrease of approximately HK\$12.1 million compared with the previous financial year. The steep reduction in interest income was mainly due to a decrease in interest rates.

資本結構及流動資金

於二零零九年三月三十一日,本集團之權益總額為港幣5,160,700,000元,於二零零八年三月三十一日則為港幣5,373,500,000元。如二零零六年十月二十日刊登之公告指出,本公司已與一間銀行訂立一份融資協議,當中包括一筆為期五年,合共港幣1,000,000,000元的定期貸款和一筆為期五年,合共港幣200,000,000元的電環貸款。在符合其他協議條件及貸款銀行同意的情況下,本公司可選擇將融資期限延長兩年。於二零零九年三月三十一日,本集團已動用的銀行信貸額達港幣568,000,000元,資本負債比率為11.0%(以銀行貸款總額除以權益總額計算)。

展望

由本公司持有之位於九龍彌敦道63號(九龍內 地段7425號)的國際廣場發展計劃工程已進入 最後階段。其上蓋於二零零九年二月平頂。內 部及外牆的裝修工程現正進行,並預計可於本 年第三季度獲得佔用許可證(「入伙紙」)。在無 不可預見的情況下,董事會預計整項計劃工程 將於二零零九年十二月前竣工,並期望國際廣 場可於二零零九年年底或之前開始營業。現估 計該項工程的建築費用約為港幣1,300,000,000元, 並將主要由外借款支付。

全球性的金融風暴已對經濟造成極大影響,香港租賃市場亦受到該影響的衝擊。管理層預計經營環境將具挑戰,但鑑於國際廣場的位置及其具質素的建築,董事會相信國際廣場於不久的將來會成為一個受歡迎的購物中心。

Capital Structure and Liquidity

The total equity for the Group at 31 March 2009 was HK\$5,160.7 million, compared with HK\$5,373.5 million at 31 March 2008. As announced on 20 October 2006, the Company has entered into a facility agreement with a bank comprising of a 5-year term loan facility of up to HK\$1 billion and a 5-year revolving credit facility of up to HK\$200 million. The Company has an option to extend the facilities for two additional years, subject to, among other things, the agreement of the lending bank. At 31 March 2009, the banking facilities were utilised to the extent of HK\$568 million and the Group's gearing ratio was 11.0% (calculated as total bank loan over total equity).

Outlook

The development of iSQUARE on the site located at No. 63 Nathan Road, Kowloon (Kowloon Inland Lot No. 7425) owned by the Company has entered its final stage. The superstructure was topped out in February 2009. Internal and external finishing works are now in progress. The occupation permit is anticipated to be obtained in the third quarter of this year. Barring unforeseen circumstances, the entire project is expected to be completed before December 2009, targeting to open for business by the end of 2009. The present estimated cost of construction for this project is around HK\$1.3 billion and this will be mainly financed by external borrowings.

The global financial turmoil has had a profound impact on the economy and such impact has affected the leasing market in Hong Kong. The management expects the operating environment to be challenging. However, given its location and quality of construction, the Directors believe that, over time, iSQUARE should become a popular shopping centre.

The Annual General Meeting of shareholders of the Company will be held on Wednesday, 9 September 2009.

Dividend

The Board has resolved that in view of the cessation of the main business of the Group which was the operation of a hotel and the hotel's shopping arcade, no final dividend will be paid to shareholders (2008: HK\$NiI). As no interim dividend was paid during the year, there will be no dividend paid for the entire year (2008: HK\$NiI). The register of members of the Company will be closed for the purpose of determining the identity of members who are entitled to attend and vote at the forthcoming Annual General Meeting from Thursday, 3 September 2009 to Wednesday, 9 September 2009, both days inclusive, during which period no transfer of shares will be effected. All transfers must be lodged with the Company's share registrars not later than 4:30 pm on Wednesday, 2 September 2009.

物業概覽 Properties

國際廣場

國際廣場是一個綜合商舖中心,並將設有多間零售商舖、娛樂消遣場所和餐廳。該中心位處優越,座落於尖沙咀的心臟地帶,交通便利。

國際廣場的上蓋於二零零九年二月平頂。內部及外牆的裝修工程現正進行。在無不可預見的情況下,董事會預計整項計劃工程將於二零零九年十二月前竣工,並期望國際廣場可於二零零九年年底或之前開始營業。

Austin Hills Golf Resort

本高爾夫球度假村位於馬來西亞新山市,共設有三個9洞高爾夫球場。其他娛樂配套設施包括網球場、高爾夫球練習場、遊戲機中心、桌球枱、8條保齡球球道、酒廊/卡拉OK和游泳池。此外,本度假村亦備有66間套房和數間食府。

iSQUARE

This commercial complex will house a number of retail, entertainment, food and beverage establishments. It is well located in the heart of Tsim Sha Tsui and easily accessible.

The superstructure was topped out in February 2009. Internal and external finishing works are now in progress. Barring unforeseen circumstances, the entire project is expected to be completed before December 2009, targeting to open for business by the end of 2009.

Austin Hills Golf Resort

This golf resort is in the city of Johor Bahru, Malaysia. There are three 9-hole golf courses. Other entertainment facilities include tennis courts, a driving range, a games room, pool tables, 8-lane bowling alleys, a lounge/karaoke and a swimming pool. There are also 66 suites and food and beverage establishments.

企業管治常規

本公司明白上市公司對股東的責任,故致力維持高水平的企業管治。為此,本公司已檢討其常規和程序,並確認和制訂合適的措施。

於二零零九年一月一日之後,本公司曾就有 否遵守《香港聯合交易所有限公司證券上市規 則》(「上市規則」) 附錄十四所載的《企業管治 常規守則》(「企管常規守則」) 中的守則條文進 行審閱。除主席和行政總裁的角色沒有按企管 常規守則中守則條文第A.2.1條的規定而分開, 並由不同人士擔任外,本公司於截至二零零九 年三月三十一日止年度內均有遵守企管常規守 則中所有當時生效的守則條文。

關於偏離企管常規守則中守則條文第A.2.1條, 鍾輝煌先生現時為本公司主席和行政總裁。董 事會認為現時的公司結構對本公司並無任何負 面影響,且相信該結構能令本集團更迅速和有 效率地作出及執行決策。

董事的證券交易

本公司已採納上市規則附錄十所載的《上市發行人董事進行證券交易的標準守則》作為本公司董事買賣本公司證券的守則(「標準守則」),並已向本公司所有董事就有否遵守標準守則作出特定查詢。所有董事皆確認於截至二零零九年三月三十一日止年度內均有遵守標準守則的所需標準。

Corporate Governance Practices

The Company recognises its responsibilities to shareholders and is therefore committed to maintaining a high standard of corporate governance. To accomplish this, the Company has reviewed its practices and procedure, and identified and formalised appropriate measures.

Subsequent to 1 January 2009, the Company has carried out a review on the compliance with the code provisions set out in the Code on Corporate Governance Practices ("CG Code") in Appendix 14 of the Rules Governing the Listing of Securities on The Stock Exchange of Hong Kong Limited ("Listing Rules"). Except for the roles of chairman and chief executive officer that were not separated and performed by two individuals, being inconsistent with code provision A.2.1 of the CG Code, the Company, throughout the year ended 31 March 2009, complied with all the code provisions in the CG Code which were then in force.

In respect of the deviation from code provision A.2.1 of the CG Code, Mr Cheong Hooi Hong is both the Chairman and chief executive officer of the Company. The Board of Directors considers that the current structure does not have any adverse effect on the Company and believes that this structure enables the Group to make and implement decisions promptly and efficiently.

Directors' Securities Transactions

The Company has adopted the Model Code for Securities Transactions by Directors of Listed Issuers set out in Appendix 10 of the Listing Rules as its code for dealing in securities in the Company by its directors ("Model Code"). Specific enquiry has been made with all directors of the Company of any non-compliance with the Model Code, and all directors have confirmed compliance with the required standard set out in the Model Code during the year ended 31 March 2009.

非執行董事和獨立非執行董事

非執行董事被委任的年期為一年,而獨立非執 行董事被委任的年期則為股東周年大會散會起 至緊隨下一次之股東周年大會散會止。根據本 公司的組織章程細則,非執行董事和獨立非執 行董事均須每三年最少輪值退任一次,唯該等 董事可膺撰連任。

本公司已收到各獨立非執行董事向本公司發出 有關其獨立性(按上市規則第3.13條所列載的 指引)的確認文件,並認為各獨立非執行董事 確屬獨立人士。其中一名獨立非執行董事擁有 上市規則要求具備的適當的專業資格或適當的 會計或相關的財務管理專長。

董事薪酬

本集團薪酬政策的最終目的是以具競爭力的薪酬令具合適才能的董事和員工留任。為此,董事會已成立薪酬委員會。按本集團薪酬政策的規定,所有董事或其聯繫人均不可參與與其薪酬有關的決定。

Non-executive Directors and Independent Non-executive Directors

The non-executive directors are appointed for a term of one year whilst independent non-executive directors are appointed for the period commencing from the conclusion of one annual general meeting to the conclusion of the following annual general meeting. According to the Company's Articles of Association, they are required to retire by rotation, but eligible for re-election, at least once every three years.

The Company has received confirmation from each independent non-executive director about his independence as set out in Rule 3.13 of the Listing Rules and considers each of them to be independent. One of the independent non-executive directors possesses appropriate professional qualifications or accounting or related financial management expertise as required under the Listing Rules.

Remuneration of Directors

The primary objective of the Group's remuneration policy is to retain directors and staff of suitable calibre by remunerating them at competitive level. In order to achieve this, the Board has established a remuneration committee. Under the Group's remuneration policy, no director or his associates is allowed to be involved in decisions relating to his own remuneration.

執行董事和高層管理人員的薪酬每年由薪酬委員會在考慮行政總裁的建議後釐定(唯鍾輝煌先生的薪酬則在無須諮詢或聽取行政總裁的建議下,由薪酬委員會全權決定)。薪酬委員會每年亦會檢討非執行董事和獨立非執行董事的薪酬,並就該等事宜向董事會作出建議。其他員工的薪酬則於每年由執行董事在考慮各有關部門主管的建議後釐定。

The remuneration committee comprises three independent non-executive directors and two non-executive directors. The members are Mr Chow Wan Hoi, Paul (committee chairman), Mr Lau Wah Sum, Mr Sin Cho Chiu, Charles, Mr Lee Chung and Mr Yau Allen Lee-nam. The main duties of the remuneration committee are to assist the Company in formulating remuneration policy and structure for directors and senior management; to determine the remuneration packages for all executive directors and senior management; to make recommendations to the Board on the remuneration for non-executive directors and independent non-executive directors; to review and approve performance-based remuneration; to review and approve compensation payable to executive directors and senior management in connection with any loss or termination of their office or appointment; and to review and approve compensation arrangements relating to dismissal or removal of directors for misconduct. Details of the remuneration committee's authority and duties are set out in the terms of reference. The said terms of reference are published on the Company's website and are also available upon written request to the company secretary.

Remuneration for executive directors and senior management is determined by the remuneration committee on the recommendations of the chief executive officer (except Mr Cheong Hooi Hong whose remuneration package is determined by the remuneration committee without recommendation of or reference to the chief executive officer) on an annual basis. The remuneration committee also makes recommendations to the Board on the review of remuneration for non-executive directors and independent non-executive directors annually. For all other staff, it is the executive directors who fix their remuneration packages on the recommendations of their respective department heads on an annual basis.

The amount of remuneration payable to the directors is determined by reference to a number of factors, including remuneration paid by comparable companies, the Group's results as well as the work-load, responsibility and time commitment of the directors. When determining the remuneration packages for senior management and all other staff, the remuneration committee and executive directors, as the case may be, take(s) into consideration the factors including market condition, the Group's results, individual performance, job nature and duties.

Other than the retirement scheme as set out in note 26 to the financial statements on page 111, the Group does not have any long-term incentive scheme.

The process for re-election of a director is pursuant to the Company's Articles of Association, which requires that (i) every director should be subject to retirement by rotation at least once every three years and a retiring director shall be eligible for re-election; and (ii) directors who are appointed by the Board as an addition to the Board shall retire at the next annual general meeting whilst those appointed to fill casual vacancies shall retire at the next general meeting (instead of the next annual general meeting) and directors so appointed are eligible for re-election.

Upon the occurrence of such an event of default, the lending bank may, among other things, demand immediate repayment of all of the loans made to the Company under the Facility Agreement together with accrued interest.

1 主要會計政策

(a) 合規聲明

本財務報表是按照香港會計師公會 頒布的所有適用的《香港財務報告 準則》,此統稱包括所有適用的 《香港財務報告準則》、《香港財務報告 計準則》和詮釋,香港公認論 則和香港《公司條例》的規定編製。 本財務報表同時符合適用的《香港 聯合交易所有限公司證券上 則》披露規定。以下是本集團採用 的主要會計政策概要。

香港會計師公會頒布了多項新的詮釋和一項經修訂的《香港財務報告準則》,這些詮釋和準則在本集團和本公司當前的會計期間首次生效。然而,這些準則變化均與本集團和本公司的業務經營無關。

本集團並無採用任何在當前會計期間尚未生效的新準則或詮釋(參閱附註30)。

1 Significant Accounting Policies

(a) Statement of compliance

These financial statements have been prepared in accordance with all applicable Hong Kong Financial Reporting Standards ("HKFRSs"), which collective term includes all applicable individual Hong Kong Financial Reporting Standards, Hong Kong Accounting Standards ("HKASs") and Interpretations issued by the Hong Kong Institute of Certified Public Accountants ("HKICPA"), accounting principles generally accepted in Hong Kong and the requirements of the Hong Kong Companies Ordinance. These financial statements also comply with the applicable disclosure provisions of the Rules Governing the Listing of Securities on The Stock Exchange of Hong Kong Limited. A summary of the significant accounting policies adopted by the Group is set out below.

The HKICPA has issued a number of new interpretations and an amendment to HKFRSs that are first effective for the current accounting period of the Group and the Company. However, none of these developments are relevant to the Group's and the Company's operations.

The Group has not applied any new standard or interpretation that is not yet effective for the current accounting period (see note 30).

(b) 財務報表的編製基準

(b) Basis of preparation of the financial statements

The consolidated financial statements for the year ended 31 March 2009 comprise the Company and its subsidiaries (together referred to as the "Group").

The measurement basis used in the preparation of the financial statements is the historical cost basis except that the investment properties are stated at their fair value as explained in the accounting policies set out in note 1(d).

The preparation of financial statements in conformity with HKFRSs requires management to make judgements, estimates and assumptions that affect the application of policies and reported amounts of assets, liabilities, income and expenses. The estimates and associated assumptions are based on historical experience and various other factors that are believed to be reasonable under the circumstances, the results of which form the basis of making the judgements about carrying values of assets and liabilities that are not readily apparent from other sources. Actual results may differ from these estimates.

The estimates and underlying assumptions are reviewed on an ongoing basis. Revisions to accounting estimates are recognised in the period in which the estimate is revised if the revision affects only that period, or in the period of the revision and future periods if the revision affects both current and future periods.

(c) Subsidiaries and minority interests

Subsidiaries are entities controlled by the Group. Control exists when the Group has the power to govern the financial and operating policies of an entity so as to obtain benefits from its activities. In assessing control, potential voting rights that presently are exercisable are taken into account.

An investment in a subsidiary is consolidated into the consolidated financial statements from the date that control commences until the date that control ceases. Intra-group balances and transactions and any unrealised profits arising from intra-group transactions are eliminated in full in preparing the consolidated financial statements. Unrealised losses resulting from intra-group transactions are eliminated in the same way as unrealised gains but only to the extent that there is no evidence of impairment.

Minority interests represent the portion of the net assets of subsidiaries attributable to interests that are not owned by the Company, whether directly or indirectly through subsidiaries, and in respect of which the Group has not agreed any additional terms with the holders of those interests which would result in the Group as a whole having a contractual obligation in respect of those interests that meets the definition of a financial liability. Minority interests are presented in the consolidated balance sheet within equity, separately from equity attributable to the equity shareholders of the Company. Minority interests in the results of the Group are presented on the face of the consolidated income statement as an allocation of the total profit or loss for the year between minority interests and the equity shareholders of the Company.

Where losses applicable to the minority exceed the minority's interest in the equity of a subsidiary, the excess, and any further losses applicable to the minority, are charged against the Group's interest except to the extent that the minority has a binding obligation to, and is able to, make additional investment to cover the losses. If the subsidiary subsequently reports profits, the Group's interest is allocated all such profits until the minority's share of losses previously absorbed by the Group has been recovered.

In the Company's balance sheet, an investment in a subsidiary is stated at cost less impairment losses (see note 1(h)), unless the investment is classified as held for sale.

(d) Investment properties

Investment properties are land and/or buildings which are owned or held under a leasehold interest (see note 1(f)) to earn rental income and/or for capital appreciation. These include land held for a currently undetermined future use.

Investment properties are stated in the balance sheet at fair value. Any gain or loss arising from a change in fair value or from the retirement or disposal of an investment property is recognised in profit or loss. Rental income from investment properties is accounted for as described in note 1(p)(ii).

Gains or losses arising from the retirement or disposal of an item of other properties, plant and equipment are determined as the difference between the net disposal proceeds and the carrying amount of the item and are recognised in profit or loss on the date of retirement or disposal.

Finance charges implicit in the lease payments are charged to profit or loss over the period of the leases so as to produce an approximately constant periodic rate of charge on the remaining balance of the obligations for each accounting period. Contingent rentals are charged to profit or loss in the accounting period in which they are incurred.

Lease incentives received are recognised in profit or loss as an integral part of the aggregate net lease payments made. Contingent rentals are charged to profit or loss in the accounting period in which they are incurred.

The cost of acquiring land held under an operating lease is amortised on a straight-line basis over the period of the lease term except where the property is classified as an investment property (see note 1(d)).

Calculation of recoverable amount

The recoverable amount of an asset is the greater of its net selling price and value in use. Where an asset does not generate cash inflows largely independent of those from other assets, the recoverable amount is determined for the smallest group of assets that generates cash inflows independently (i.e. a cashgenerating unit).

Recognition of impairment losses

An impairment loss is recognised in profit or loss whenever the carrying amount of an asset, or the cashgenerating unit to which it belongs, exceeds its recoverable amount. Impairment losses recognised in respect of cash-generating units are allocated to reduce the carrying amount of the assets in the unit (or group of units) on a pro rata basis, except that the carrying value of an asset will not be reduced below its individual fair value less costs to sell, or value in use, if determinable.

Reversals of impairment losses

An impairment loss is reversed if there has been a favourable change in the estimates used to determine the recoverable amount. A reversal of an impairment loss is limited to the asset's carrying amount that would have been determined had no impairment loss been recognised in prior years. Reversals of impairment losses are credited to profit or loss in the year in which the reversals are recognised.

Inventories comprise of stocks of beverages and consumables, are carried at the lower of cost and net realisable value.

Cost is calculated on the first-in, first-out basis and comprises all costs of purchase and other costs incurred in bringing the inventories to their present location and condition.

Net realisable value is the estimated selling price in the ordinary course of business less the estimated costs necessary to make the sale.

When inventories are sold, the carrying amount of those inventories is recognised as an expense in the period in which the related revenue is recognised. The amount of any writedown of inventories to net realisable value and all losses of inventories are recognised as an expense in the period the write-down or loss occurs. The amount of any reversal of any write-down of inventories is recognised as a reduction in the amount of inventories recognised as an expense in the period in which the reversal occurs.

Accounts and other receivables are initially recognised at fair value and thereafter stated at amortised cost less allowance for impairment of bad and doubtful debts, except where the receivables are interest-free loans made to related parties without any fixed repayment terms or the effect of discounting would be immaterial. In such cases, the receivables are stated at cost less allowance for impairment of bad and doubtful debts.

Impairment losses of bad and doubtful debts are recognised when there is objective evidence of impairment and are measured as the difference between the carrying amount of the financial asset and the estimated future cash flows, discounted at the asset's original effective interest rate where the effect of discounting is material. Objective evidence of impairment includes observable data that comes to the attention of the Group about events that have an impact on the asset's estimated future cash flows such as significant financial difficulty of the debtor.

Impairment losses for accounts receivable included within accounts and other receivables whose recovery is considered doubtful but not remote are recorded using an allowance account. When the Group is satisfied that recovery is remote, the amount considered irrecoverable is written off against accounts receivable directly and any amounts held in the allowance account relating to that debt are reversed. Subsequent recoveries of amounts previously charged to the allowance account are reversed against the allowance account. Other changes in the allowance account and subsequent recoveries of amounts previously written off directly are recognised in profit or loss.

Cash and cash equivalents comprise cash at bank and in hand, demand deposits with banks and other financial institutions, and short-term, highly liquid investments that are readily convertible into known amounts of cash and which are subject to an insignificant risk of changes in value, having been within three months of maturity at acquisition. Bank overdrafts that are repayable on demand and form an integral part of the Group's cash management are also included as a component of cash and cash equivalents for the purpose of the consolidated cash flow statement.

Where payment or settlement is deferred and the effect would be material, these amounts are stated at their present values.

(ii) Termination benefits

Termination benefits are recognised when, and only when, the Group demonstrably commits itself to terminate employment or to provide benefits as a result of voluntary redundancy by having a detailed formal plan which is without realistic possibility of withdrawal.

(n) Income tax

Income tax for the year comprises current tax and movements in deferred tax assets and liabilities. Current tax and movements in deferred tax assets and liabilities are recognised in profit or loss except to the extent that they relate to items recognised directly in equity, in which case they are recognised in equity.

Current tax is the expected tax payable on the taxable income for the year, using tax rates enacted or substantively enacted at the balance sheet date, and any adjustment to tax payable in respect of previous years.

Deferred tax assets and liabilities arise from deductible and taxable temporary differences respectively, being the differences between the carrying amounts of assets and liabilities for financial reporting purposes and their tax bases. Deferred tax assets also arise from unused tax losses and unused tax credits.

Future taxable profits that may support the recognition of deferred tax assets arising from deductible temporary differences include those that will arise from the reversal of existing taxable temporary differences, provided those differences relate to the same taxation authority and the same taxable entity, and are expected to reverse either in the same period as the expected reversal of the deductible temporary difference or in periods into which a tax loss arising from the deferred tax asset can be carried back or forward. The same criteria are adopted when determining whether existing taxable temporary differences support the recognition of deferred tax assets arising from unused tax losses and credits, that is, those differences are taken into account if they relate to the same taxation authority and the same taxable entity, and are expected to reverse in a period, or periods, in which the tax loss or credit can be utilised.

The limited exceptions to recognition of deferred tax assets and liabilities are the initial recognition of assets or liabilities that affect neither accounting nor taxable profit (provided they are not part of a business combination), and temporary differences relating to investments in subsidiaries to the extent that, in the case of taxable differences, the Group controls the timing of the reversal and it is probable that the differences will not reverse in the foreseeable future, or in the case of deductible differences, unless it is probable that they will reverse in the future.

The amount of deferred tax recognised is measured based on the expected manner of realisation or settlement of the carrying amount of the assets and liabilities, using tax rates enacted or substantively enacted at the balance sheet date. Deferred tax assets and liabilities are not discounted.

Current tax balances and deferred tax balances, and movements therein, are presented separately from each other and are not offset. Current tax assets are offset against current tax liabilities, and deferred tax assets against deferred tax liabilities, if the Company or the Group has the legally enforceable right to set off current tax assets against current tax liabilities and the following additional conditions are met:

- in the case of current tax assets and liabilities, the Company or the Group intends either to settle on a net basis, or to realise the asset and settle the liability simultaneously; or
- in the case of deferred tax assets and liabilities, if they relate to income taxes levied by the same taxation authority on either:
 - the same taxable entity; or
 - different taxable entities, which, in each future period in which significant amounts of deferred tax liabilities or assets are expected to be settled or recovered, intend to realise the current tax assets and settle the current tax liabilities on a net basis or realise and settle simultaneously.

Possible obligations, whose existence will only be confirmed by the occurrence or non-occurrence of one or more future events are also disclosed as contingent liabilities unless the probability of outflow of economic benefits is remote.

(p) Revenue recognition

Provided it is probable that the economic benefits will flow to the Group and the revenue and costs, if applicable, can be measured reliably, revenue is recognised in profit or loss as follows:

(i) Golf and recreational club and related services Revenue arising from golf and recreational club operation is recognised when the relevant services are provided.

(iii) Interest income Interest income is recognised as it accrues using the effective interest method.

Foreign currency transactions during the year are translated at the foreign exchange rates ruling at the transaction dates. Monetary assets and liabilities denominated in foreign currencies are translated at the foreign exchange rates ruling at the balance sheet date. Exchange gains and losses are recognised in profit or loss.

Non-monetary assets and liabilities that are measured in terms of historical cost in a foreign currency are translated using the foreign exchange rates ruling at the transaction dates. Non-monetary assets and liabilities denominated in foreign currencies that are stated at fair value are translated using the foreign exchange rates ruling at the dates the fair value was determined.

(r) Borrowing costs

Borrowing costs are expensed in profit or loss in the period in which they are incurred, except to the extent that they are capitalised as being directly attributable to the acquisition, construction or production of an asset which necessarily takes a substantial period of time to get ready for its intended use or sale.

The capitalisation of borrowing costs as part of the cost of a qualifying asset commences when expenditure for the asset is being incurred, borrowing costs are being incurred and activities that are necessary to prepare the asset for its intended use or sale are in progress. Capitalisation of borrowing costs is suspended or ceases when substantially all the activities necessary to prepare the qualifying asset for its intended use or sale are interrupted or complete.

Segment revenue, expenses, results, assets and liabilities include items directly attributable to a segment as well as those that can be allocated on a reasonable basis to that segment. For example, segment assets may include inventories, accounts receivable and properties, plant and equipment. Segment revenue, expenses, assets, and liabilities are determined before intra-group balances and intra-group transactions are eliminated as part of the consolidation process, except to the extent that such intra-group balances and transactions are between group entities within a single segment. Inter-segment pricing is based on similar terms as those available to other external parties.

Segment capital expenditure is the total cost incurred during the period to acquire segment assets (both tangible and intangible) that are expected to be used for more than one period.

Unallocated items mainly comprise financial and corporate assets, borrowings, tax balances, corporate and financing expenses.

During the terms or at the expiry of the preference shares which ranges from 5 to 30 years, the holders of these shares have the option to convert their shares into ordinary shares, by paying the difference between the consideration of allotment of ordinary and preference shares or such other price as the Board of Directors of AHCRB may decide which shall entitle the holders of such conversion golf membership of the club in perpetuity subject to any adjustments in relation to the issued price based on the instalment scheme offered by AHCRB. Should the preference shares not be converted into ordinary shares at the expiry date, they will be redeemed at par value.

The Directors consider that the dilution effect of the share issued on the Group's interest in AHCRB is not material.

(f) Capital management

The Group's primary objectives when managing capital are to safeguard the Group's ability to continue as a going concern, so that it can continue to provide returns for equity shareholders and benefit for other stakeholders, by redeveloping and leasing properties, and pricing services commensurately with the level of risk and by securing access to finance at a reasonable cost.

The Group regularly reviews and manages its capital structure to maintain a balance between the higher shareholder returns that might be possible with higher levels of borrowings and the advantages and security afforded by a sound capital position, and makes adjustments to the capital structure in light of changes in economic conditions. The Group's overall strategy remained unchanged during the years ended 31 March 2009 and 2008.

The Group monitors its capital structure by reviewing its gearing ratio and cash flow requirements, taking into account its future financial obligations and commitments. For this purpose, the Group defines gearing ratio as total bank loan over total equity as shown in the consolidated balance sheet. As at 31 March 2009, the Group's gearing ratio was 11.0% (2008: 2.4%) with total bank loan exceeding bank deposits and cash of \$120,888,000 (2008: bank deposits and cash exceeding total bank loan of \$344,145,000).

25 Financial Risk Management and Fair Values

Exposure to credit, liquidity, interest rate and currency risks arises in the normal course of the Group's business.

The Group's exposure to these risks and the financial risk management policies and practices used by the Group to manage these risks are described below.

Credit risk (a)

The Group's credit risk is primarily attributable to accounts receivable. Management has a credit policy in place and the exposures to this credit risk is monitored on an ongoing basis.

In respect of accounts receivable, individual credit evaluations are performed on all customers requiring credit over a certain amount. These evaluations focus on the customer's past history of making payments when due and current ability to pay, and take into account information specific to the customer as well as pertaining to the economic environment in which the customer operates. Debts are generally due after 60 days in respect of golf and recreational club operation and within 14 days in respect of property leasing from the date of billing. Accounts for members of the golf and recreational club with balances that are 90 days past due are suspended and such action will be taken against defaulting members as may be appropriate. For debtors of property leasing, legal action will be taken against past due debtors whenever the situation is appropriate. The Group obtains deposits from customers (see note 19) as collateral over accounts receivable.

Further quantitative disclosures in respect of the Group's exposure to credit risk arising from accounts receivable are set out in note 15.

(b) Liquidity risk

The Group's policy is to regularly monitor current and expected liquidity requirements and its compliance with lending covenants, to ensure that it maintains sufficient reserves of cash and an adequate amount of committed banking facilities to meet its liquidity requirements in the short and longer term.

26 Employee Retirement Benefits

The Group operates a Mandatory Provident Fund Scheme (the "MPF scheme") under the Hong Kong Mandatory Provident Fund Schemes Ordinance for employees employed under the jurisdiction of the Hong Kong Employment Ordinance. The MPF scheme is a defined contribution retirement plan administrated by independent trustees. Under the MPF scheme, the employer and its employees are each required to make contributions to the plan at 5% of the employees' relevant income, subject to a cap of monthly relevant income of \$20,000. In addition to the mandatory contribution, the Group makes voluntary contribution at 5% of the employees' monthly relevant income in excess of \$20,000, subject to a maximum monthly income of \$30,000. Contributions to the plan vest immediately. The staff costs in respect of staff employed by DTZ for building and property management of iSQUARE are reflected in the Group's income statement.

The employees of the Group's subsidiaries in Malaysia and Singapore are members of the Employee Provident Fund and the Central Provident Fund (the "funds") operated by the respective local government. The relevant subsidiaries are required to contribute to the funds at rates ranging from 7.5% to 14.5% based on the salaries of the employees. The only obligation of the Group to the above funds is the required contributions at the applicable rate.

During the year, no forfeited contributions (2008: \$51,000) was utilised to reduce the contributions payable for the year. No unutilised forfeited contributions had yet to be applied by the Group at 31 March 2009 and 2008.

In November 2007, an overseas subsidiary filed a claim in court against a subscriber of the golf club membership in Malaysia for the payment of approximately \$1.3 million being the remaining outstanding balance for certain preference shares of the subsidiary. However, the subscriber disputed the claim and filed a counterclaim of approximately \$4.7 million on 28 January 2008 on the alleged grounds that the subscriber had suffered loss of reputation and other losses.

In August 2008, the overseas subsidiary and the subscriber agreed to settle by withdrawing their respective claims against each other and a notice of discontinuance for this purpose was filed in court. The case was closed upon the judge striking out the above claims in December 2008. Accordingly, the Directors are of the opinion that no provision for the counterclaim is necessary.

29 Immediate Parent and Ultimate Controlling Party

At 31 March 2009, the Directors consider the immediate parent and ultimate controlling party of the Group to be Tian Teck Land Limited and Tian Teck Investment Holding Co., Limited respectively, both of which are incorporated in Hong Kong. The immediate parent produces financial statements available for public use and the ultimate controlling party does not produce financial statements available for public use.
