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## GLOSSARY

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The glossary of technical terms contains explanations and definitions of certain terms used in this prospectus in connection with us and our business. The terms and their meaning may not correspond to meanings or usage of these terms as used by others.

“GMP”	acronym for “good manufacturing practice,” guidelines and regulations issued from time to time pursuant to PRC laws as part of quality assurance to ensure that health food products and pharmaceutical products subject to those guidelines and regulations are consistently produced and controlled to the quality and standards appropriate for their intended use
“health food product”	a food product which has been approved by the SFDA as having one or more of the 27 categories of health benefits under China’s health food regulatory framework; upon approval by the SFDA, a “health” (“健”) mark may be affixed on such product’s packaging
“OEM”	acronym for “original equipment manufacturing,” whereby products are manufactured in accordance with a customer’s specifications for sale under the customer’s brand
“OTC”	acronym for “over-the-counter,” used to identify drug products that may be sold without a prescription
“OTC drug”	drug products that may be sold without a prescription; upon approval by the SFDA, an “OTC” mark must be affixed on such product’s packaging; such drug products may only be sold by entities holding a pharmaceutical distribution permit, principally including pharmacies and hospitals
“OTC tea”	a tea-based OTC drug product
“SPV”	acronym for “special purpose vehicle,” a legal entity (usually a limited company or a limited partnership) created to fulfill narrow, specific or temporary objectives
“therapeutic tea”	a tea-based health food product
