This announcement is made by the Bank pursuant to Rule 13.09 of the Rules Governing the Listing of Securities on The Stock Exchange of Hong Kong Limited.

1.4.3 Accumulated conversion of convertible bonds during the reporting period

The applicable conversion period for the Bank's RMB40 billion A-Share convertible bonds issued on 2 June 2010 did not commence during the reporting period.

1.4.4 Historical adjustments of conversion price

The Bank issued RMB40 billion of convertible bonds on 2 June 2010.

On 27 May 2010, the Bank's 2009 profit distribution plan was approved at its 2009 Annual General Meeting. The Bank published its announcement on A-Share dividend distribution in the newspapers selected for information disclosure, namely *China Securities*, *Shanghai Securities* and *Securities Times*, as well as the website of the Shanghai Stock Exchange, on 31 May 2010. The Bank adjusted the conversion price from RMB4.02 to RMB3.88 per share in accordance with the "Determination and Adjustment of Conversion Price" provision, effective from 3 June 2010 (equity registration day for dividend distribution). The conversion price of the convertible bonds on the first day of trading was RMB3.88. For details, please refer to the *Prospectus of Public Offering of Convertible Bonds of Bank of China Limited* published on the website of the Shanghai Stock Exchange.

1.4.5 The Bank's outstanding debts, creditworthiness and availability of cash for repayment of debts in future years

The Bank's risk management capability is improving continually along with its increasingly enhanced capital base and overall operational sophistication. The Bank's adequate capital base, stable mix of assets and liabilities and healthy profitability provide a solid foundation for the repayment of its debts.

Under a sound corporate governance structure, the Bank is transparent in its financial position, efficient in its management and prudent in its operations. The Bank maintains a healthy liquidity position and has no record of default. The Bank will further enhance its management and improve its operational efficiency in the future, ensuring its ability of debt repayment in a timely manner.

1.4.6 Significant changes to the profitability, asset condition and creditworthiness of the convertible bonds guarantor

There is no guarantee or security in relation to the Bank's issuance of the convertible bonds.

II. SUMMARY OF ANALYSIS ON OVERALL OPERATING ACTIVITIES

Since 2010, the Bank continued to adopt the scientific outlook on development and pushed forward the implementation of its strategic development plan in a complex and volatile operating environment. By earnestly implementing the principles of streamlining structure, scaling up, managing risks and sharpening competitiveness, the Bank achieved sound operating results. In the first three quarters of 2010, the Group recorded a profit for the period of RMB82.960 billion¹, an increase of 27.48% compared with the same period of 2009. Earnings per share (basic) were RMB0.31, an increase of RMB0.07 compared with the same period of 2009. Return on average equity (annualised) was 19.54% and return on average total assets (annualised) was 1.17%, an increase of 2.37 percentage points and 0.04 percentage point, respectively, compared with the same period of 2009.

2.1 The principal components of the Group's income statement for the nine-month period ended 30 September 2010 were as follows:

1. The Group earned net interest income of RMB140.804 billion, an increase of RMB25.194 billion or 21.79% compared with the same period of 2009. Net interest margin of the Group was 2.04%, an increase of 0.01 percentage point compared with the same period of 2009. Net interest margin of domestic RMB businesses increased, whereas that of domestic foreign currency businesses moderately decreased compared with the same period of 2009. It was mainly attributable to: (1) the Bank further optimised its interest-earning asset structure to increase the proportion of high-yield assets, while actively developed its RMB businesses to expand the scale and proportion of its RMB-denominated assets to total assets; and (2) the decrease of average interest rates for domestic foreign currency interest-bearing liabilities was lower than the average rate of return of foreign currency interest-earning assets, leading to a narrower interest spread.
2. Non-interest income of the Group amounted to RMB61.493 billion, an increase of RMB8.359 billion or 15.73% compared with the same period of 2009. Net fee and commission income amounted to RMB41.344 billion, an increase of RMB6.831 billion or 19.79% compared with the same period of 2009. Other non-interest income amounted to RMB20.149 billion, an increase of RMB1.528 billion or 8.21% compared with the same period of 2009.
3. The Group recorded operating expenses of RMB84.465 billion, an increase of RMB11.696 billion or 16.07% compared with the same period of 2009. The increase was largely attributable to the workforce expansion, increased expenditure for infrastructure construction, and the increase in its expenses of insurance and precious metals businesses. The Group's cost to income ratio (calculated under domestic regulations) was 31.34%, a decrease of 0.63 percentage point compared with the same period of 2009.

4. The Group's impairment losses on assets amounted to RMB11.162 billion, comprising:
- (1) Impairment losses on loans and advances amounted to RMB13.579 billion with a credit cost of 0.35%. As at 30 September 2010, the Group reported identified impaired loans totalling RMB62.711 billion, a decrease of RMB13.295 billion from the prior year-end; and the ratio of identified impaired loans to total loans was 1.13%, down by 0.42 percentage point compared with the end of 2009. The ratio of non-performing loans to total loans was 1.10%, a decrease of 0.42 percentage point from the prior year-end. The ratio of allowance for loan impairment losses to non-performing loans was 198.93%, up by 47.76 percentage points from the prior year-end.
 - (2) The reversal of impairment losses on debt securities amounted to RMB2.408 billion.

2.2 The principal components of the Group's financial position as at 30 September 2010 were as follows:

The Group's total assets amounted to RMB10,102.435 billion, an increase of RMB1,350.492 billion or 15.43% compared with the prior year-end, and total liabilities amounted to RMB9,504.490 billion, an increase of RMB1,297.941 billion or 15.82% compared with the end of 2009.

1. The Group's deposits from customers amounted to RMB7,438.576 billion, an increase of RMB818.024 billion or 12.36% compared with the end of 2009. As at 30 September 2010, domestic RMB-denominated deposits amounted to RMB5,953.029 billion, an increase of RMB641.628 billion or 12.08% from the prior year-end.
2. The Group's loans and advances to customers amounted to RMB5,555.171 billion, an increase of RMB644.813 billion or 13.13% compared with the prior year-end. Since 2010, the Bank continued to implement government policies, support a reasonable credit supply, enhance credit risk management and accelerate adjustments to its loan structure, promoting the healthy development of its loan business. As at 30 September 2010, domestic RMB-denominated loans amounted to RMB4,053.592 billion, an increase of RMB543.356 billion or 15.48% compared with the prior year-end.
3. The Group held investment securities² of RMB2,055.063 billion, an increase of RMB238.384 billion or 13.12% compared with the prior year-end. The Group's RMB-denominated investment securities amounted to RMB1,499.776 billion, an increase of RMB219.439 billion or 17.14% from 2009. The balance of foreign currency-denominated investment securities was USD82.865 billion, an increase of USD4.317 billion or 5.50% compared with the prior year-end. As at 30 September 2010, the proportion of RMB-denominated investment securities was 72.98%, an increase of 2.50 percentage points compared with the prior year-end.

² Investment securities include available for sale securities, held to maturity securities, securities classified as loans and receivables, and financial assets at fair value through profit or loss.

As at 30 September 2010, the carrying value of US subprime mortgage related debt securities, US Alt-A mortgage-backed securities and Non-Agency US mortgage-backed securities held by the Group amounted to USD3.317 billion (or RMB22.228 billion) and the related impairment allowance was USD2.661 billion (or RMB17.833 billion).

As at 30 September 2010, the carrying value of the debt securities issued by Portugal, Ireland, Italy, Greece and Spain held by the Group amounted to RMB2.785 billion, a decrease of RMB4.235 billion compared with the prior year-end, principally a result of partial disposal of the debt securities issued by these governments and financial institutions. The total carrying value of these debt securities held by the Group exceeded cost. The Group will continue to follow the developments of related issues.
