Year at a Glance

January - March



Gas-fired generation increases to 33% of total output at Lamma Power Station.



RPCL in Thailand continues to contribute to the Energy Development Fund for the social and human development of the provincial government.

Employee Wellness Programme promotes work-life balance.

Lamma Winds generates four million units of green electricity since commissioning.



Five more self-learning centres join the University of Third Age (U3A) Programme as it enters into the $5^{\rm th}$ year.

April - June



Environmental Impact Assessment of Lamma offshore wind farm project approved. On-site wind monitoring will be carried out to facilitate detailed planning.

July - September

CitiPower and Powercor exceed all Government Advanced Meter deployment targets four months ahead of schedule.



Secondary student programme attracts young talents to take up engineering discipline in university study.

"CAREnival for the Elderly" appoints 300 elderly ambassadors to help identify hidden elders in the community.

E-bills promotion campaign to encourage a low carbon lifestyle.



Commissions Hong Kong's largest solar power system at Lamma Power Station. The system comprises 5,500 thin-film photovoltaic modules each with peak output of 100 watt.

October - December



Price Review for ETSA, CitiPower and Powercor (2011 – 2015) completes with an increase in approved net capital expenditure over the last 5-year period.

Launches the first quick charging station and an electric vehicle leasing scheme following the introduction of ten Mitsubishi iMiEV electric vehicles to the company fleet.



Acquires a 40% interest in UK's largest power distributor – UK Power Networks, which comprises three regional networks and provides nearly a quarter of the electrical power in the UK.



Over 1,200 employees and families join in HK Electric Family Day. Sale contract for the Clean Development Mechanism credits of Laoting and Dali secured.

HK Electric Clean Energy Fund extends sponsorship to 12 schools in RE projects promotion.
