- (3) If there is a “black” rainstorm warning or a tropical cyclone warning signal number eight or above in force in Hong Kong at any time between 9:00 a.m. and 12:00 noon on Monday, 5 March 2012, the application lists of the Hong Kong Public Offer will not open and close on that day.
