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## GLOSSARY OF TECHNICAL TERMS

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“boar(s)” (公豬)	male hogs which are not castrated
“breeder hog(s)” (種豬)	particularly prime hog(s) of satisfactory qualities that is selected as breeding stock, including boars and gilts
“commodity hog(s)” (商品豬)	hog(s) of about 60 to 180 days old which can be sold at the hog market
“curtain-barn(s)” (欄舍)	a long, open building with curtains on the long sides of the barn
“farrowing”	to give birth to a litter of piglets
“finisher(s)”	hog(s) that weigh(s) over 100 kg and around 180 days old before slaughtering
“FMD” (口蹄症)	foot-and-mouth disease
“gilt(s)” (後備母豬)	female hog(s) that not yet farrowed
“piglet(s)” (乳豬)	newborn hog(s) of about 0 to 30 days old
“PRRS” (藍耳病)	porcine reproductive and respiratory syndrome, also known as blue ear pig disease
“sow(s)” (母豬)	female hog(s) that has farrowed
“weaner(s)” (保育豬)	young hog(s) of around 30 to 60 days old and of weight approximately 10 to 20 kg
“whole hog carcass(es)” (白條豬肉)	half of the portion of a slaughtered hog after removal of all its internal organs and head (unless the contents in this prospectus otherwise specify)
