

YEAR AT A GLANCE

JANUARY – MARCH



- Following a successful listing exercise, HKEI commences trading on the Main Board of Hong Kong Stock Exchange on 29 January.
- HK Electric Managing Director meets over 600 employees to present and take questions on the spin-off exercise and HK Electric's 2014-2018 Development Plan.
- About forty members of the Customer Liaison Group are briefed at its annual meeting on the operations of the Lamma Power Station, the company's customer services initiatives and the 2014 tariff review.

- The government publishes a consultation paper on the future fuel mix for electricity generation. Following extensive dialogue with stakeholders, HK Electric submits its response in favour of keeping generation local while increasing the use of natural gas in the fuel mix.
- A fire drill involving mock casualties is organised at the Lamma Power Station to test the company's emergency preparedness.



APRIL – JUNE



- A huge turnout marks HKEI's first Annual General Meeting with nearly 1,000 holders of Share Stapled Units attending.
- HK Electric wins the "Public Service of the Year" for the sixth consecutive year at the Asia Pacific Customer Service Consortium Customer Relationship Excellence Awards, in addition to seven other individual awards.
- HK Electric's team of volunteers celebrates its 10th anniversary and pledges to continue caring for the community and the environment.

- HK Electric commissions the Heung Yip Road Infeed Substation and the first distribution substation at Ocean Park Station for the MTR South Island Line (East) railway project.
- The Smart Power Fund is launched to help owners of residential buildings carry out energy efficiency enhancement works for their buildings. Six applications have been approved up to end 2014.



JULY – SEPTEMBER

- “7 Habits of Highly Effective People” workshops conducted for over 200 employees to support their personal and professional advancement.
- Over 50 members of the Eco-Quality Home Club attend a health seminar, learning first-hand benefits of electric kitchens and the convenience of the latest cordless charging technology.
- HK Electric deploys more electric vehicles for operational use. It also extends the free charging service at electric vehicle charging stations operated by HK Electric till the end of 2015.



- HK Electric’s bill takes on a new look to give customers clearer information at a glance.
- Community groups including Wan Chai District Council and Lamma Rural Committee join the “Caring for the Elderly” programme, visiting single elderly and encouraging them to reach out to the community.



OCTOBER – DECEMBER

- Preparatory work commences for the construction of a new gas-fired generating unit L10 with target commissioning date in 2020 to sustain supply reliability.
- HK Electric announces decision to freeze tariff for another year, keeping net tariffs for 2015 at their 2013 levels.
- The HK Electric Institute is set up to provide advanced power engineering training programmes for developing staff, attracting talent and retaining experiences.
- More than 1,200 people join the second Green Hong Kong Green Eco-tour Festival which promotes public understanding and appreciation of local eco-heritage resources.
- Stable supply of natural gas secured by extending a gas contract with a major supplier.
