The board of directors (the "Board") of China Longyuan Power Group Corporation Limited* (the "Company") announces that, according to the Company's preliminary statistics, the power generation of the Company and its subsidiaries (the "Group") for August 2015 on consolidated basis amounted to 2,468,718MWh, representing an increase of 14.65% compared with the corresponding period of 2014. In particular, the wind power generation registered an increase of 28.05%, the coal power generation registered a decrease of 2.33% and other renewable energy power generation of the Group for 2015 amounted to 24,276,878 MWh, representing an increase of 13.12% compared with the corresponding period of 2014. In particular, the wind power generation registered an increase of 19.74%, the coal power generation registered an increase of 13.33%, and other renewable energy power generation registered a decrease of 25.00%.
