1. SHARE CAPITAL

Subject to the passing of the ordinary resolution set out in item 5 of the notice of the Annual General Meeting in respect of the granting of the Share Repurchase Mandate and on the basis that the total number of the issued Shares of the Company remains unchanged from the Latest Practicable Date up to the date of the Annual General Meeting, i.e. being 1,637,641,000 Shares, the Directors would be authorized under the Share Repurchase Mandate to repurchase, during the period in which the Share Repurchase Mandate remains in force, a maximum of 163,764,100 Shares (equivalent to an aggregate nominal amount of Shares of HK\$16,376,410.00).

2. REASONS FOR SHARE REPURCHASE

Profit East Limited is beneficially owned by Ms. Zhao Ying, non-executive Director of the Company. In the event that the Directors exercise the proposed Share Repurchase Mandate in full, the shareholding of Profit East Limited would be increased to approximately 70.74% of the total number of the issued Shares of the Company.

The Directors consider that such increase in shareholding would not give rise to an obligation for Profit East Limited to make a mandatory offer under Rule 26 of the Takeovers Code but would reduce the number of Shares held by the public to less than 25% of the total number of the issued Shares of the Company. - (ii) the expiration of the period within which the next annual general meeting of the Company is required by the articles of association of the Company or any applicable laws to be held; and
- (iii) the date on which the authority set out in this resolution is revoked or varied by an ordinary resolution of the shareholders in general meeting."
