This announcement is made by the Company pursuant to Rule 13.09(2)(a) of the Listing Rules and the Inside Information Provisions (as defined under the Listing Rules) under Part XIVA of the Securities and Futures Ordinance (Chapter 571 of the Laws of Hong Kong).

The Board wishes to inform the shareholders and potential investors that, based on a preliminary assessment of the unaudited consolidated management accounts of the Group for the three months ended 31 March 2026, the Group is expected to record a consolidated net profit attributable to shareholders of the parent company and other equity holders ranging from RMB380,000 thousand to RMB400,000 thousand for the three months ended 31 March 2026, representing an increase as compared to the corresponding period of the previous year (corresponding period of last year: profit of RMB240,372 thousand).

Shareholders and potential investors are advised to exercise caution when dealing in the shares of the Company.

This announcement is made by Delton Technology (Guangzhou) Inc. (the “**Company**”, together with its subsidiaries, the “**Group**”) pursuant to Rule 13.09(2)(a) of the Rules Governing the Listing of Securities on The Stock Exchange of Hong Kong Limited (the “**Listing Rules**”) and the Inside Information Provisions (as defined in the Listing Rules) under Part XIVA of the Securities and Futures Ordinance (Chapter 571 of the Laws of Hong Kong).

The board of directors of the Company (the “**Board**”) wishes to inform the shareholders of the Company (the “**Shareholders**”) and potential investors that, based on a preliminary assessment of the unaudited consolidated management accounts of the Group for the three months ended 31 March 2026, the Group is expected to record a consolidated net profit attributable to Shareholders of the parent company and other equity holders ranging from RMB380,000 thousand to RMB400,000 thousand for the three months ended 31 March 2026, representing an increase as compared to the corresponding period of the previous year (corresponding period of last year: profit of RMB240,372 thousand).

The Group’s estimated consolidated operational results for the three months ended 31 March 2026 are as follows:

The Group’s estimated consolidated results for January to March 2026 represent an increase as compared to the corresponding period of last year, which was primarily due to the following reasons: (1) during the three months ended 31 March 2026, the Company seized the market opportunities arising from the surge in demand for computing power hardware. By closely adhering to the theme of “computing power,” the Company remained steadfastly focused on the computing power PCB market, including general-purpose servers, AI servers, switch products, and accelerator cards. Driven by technological innovation, the Company optimized its product mix and enhanced production efficiency through digitalization, leading to a steady improvement in operating results; (2) the Company’s overseas factory, Delton Technology (Thailand) Co., Ltd. (“**Thailand Delton**”), completed the audit and certification process for its core customers as scheduled. With the certification of key customers and product implementation, coupled with the release of production capacity from Phase I of Thailand Delton, it has become the “second engine” driving the sales growth of the Company’s computing power products and achieved profitability during the reporting period; and (3) during the three months ended 31 March 2026, Delton Precision Circuits (Huangshi) Inc., a wholly-owned subsidiary of the Company, continued to promote cost control, adjust its product mix, and improve production efficiency during the reporting period, resulting in a significant year-on-year improvement in its profitability.

The Company is still in the process of preparing the consolidated financial statements of the Group for the three months ended 31 March 2026. The information contained in this announcement is only based on the internal consolidated management accounts of the Group and a preliminary estimate made by the management of the Company, and is not based on any figures or information audited or reviewed by the Company’s auditors.

Shareholders and potential investors are advised to read this announcement and the first quarterly results announcement of the Group for 2026, which is expected to be published by the end of April 2026, carefully and to exercise caution when dealing in the shares of the Company.
