- Share premium represented the excess of share issue over the par value.
- Other reserve represented the difference between the Group's share of nominal values of the paid-up capital of the subsidiary acquired over the Group's cost of acquisition of the subsidiary under common control upon Reorganisation.

On 20 March 2019, the Group's deemed disposal 27.63% equity interests of Zioncom Vietnam, an indirect wholly owned subsidiary of the Company, increased the registered capital of Zioncom Vietnam from US\$5,500,000 to US\$7,600,000. The non-controlling interests of Zioncom Vietnam agreed to pay US\$2,100,000 for the increased capital of Zioncom Vietnam. The Group recognised an increase in other reserve of approximately HK\$7,559,000.

- Subsidiaries of the Company established in the People's Republic of China (the "PRC") and Taiwan shall appropriate 10% of its annual statutory net profit (after offsetting any prior years' losses) to the statutory reserve fund account in accordance with the PRC Company Law and Taiwan Act. When the balance of such reserve fund reaches 50% of the entity's share capital, any further appropriation is optional. The statutory reserve fund can be utilised to offset prior year's losses or to increase capital after proper approval.
- Exchange reserve comprises all foreign exchange differences arising from the translation of the financial statements of operations outside Hong Kong.
- Revaluation surplus reserve represents the revaluation gains or losses arising on the land and building situated in the PRC, for such reclassifications, the cumulative increase in fair value at the date of reclassification in excess of any previous accumulative depreciation and impairment losses is included in the property revaluation reserve, and will be transferred to retained earnings upon the retirement or disposal of the relevant property.

Notes:

1. GENERAL INFORMATION

The Company was incorporated in the Cayman Islands under the Companies Law as an exempted company with limited liability on 29 January 2016. The registered office of the Company is located at P.O. Box 1350, Clifton House, 75 Fort Street, Grand Cayman, KYI-1108, Cayman Islands and the principal place of business of the Company is located in Office A, 9/F Kings Wing Plaza 2, No 1 On Kwan Street, Shatin, New Territories, Hong Kong.

The Company's immediate and ultimate holding companies are Lincats (BVI) Limited, a company incorporated in the British Virgin Islands ("**BVI**"), and Absolute Skill Holdings Limited ("**Absolute Skill**"), an investment holding company incorporated in Samoa with limited liability. Lincats (BVI) Limited is controlled by Mr. Kim Byung Kwon, an executive director of the Company. Absolute Skill is wholly-owned by Ms. Sui Xiaoho, who is also its director.

The Company is an investment holding company and its subsidiaries are principally engaged in the manufacturing and sales of networking products and non-networking products.

The shares of the Company (the "**Shares**") have been listed on GEM of The Stock Exchange by way of placing and public offer (collectively the "**Share Offer**") on 18 January 2018 (the "**Listing Date**").

On the Listing Date, a total of 198,000,000 new Shares with nominal value of HK\$0.01 each were offered under the Share Offer, of which 138,600,000 Shares, or 70% was offered by way of placing and the remaining 30%, or 59,400,000 Shares, was offered under the public offer. Based on the final offer price of HK\$0.43 per share, the gross proceeds was approximately HK\$85,140,000. The net proceeds received by the Company from the Share Offer, after deduction of the underwriting commission and related expenses in connection with the Share Offer, was approximately HK\$42,475,000.

The unaudited condensed consolidated financial statements are presented in Hong Kong dollars ("**HK\$**"). The functional currency of the Company and its principal subsidiaries are Hong Kong dollars and U.S. dollars and all values are rounded to the nearest thousands (HK\$'000), unless otherwise stated.

2. REORGANISATION

In connection with the listing of the Shares on GEM of the Stock Exchange, the Company underwent a reorganisation (the "**Reorganisation**").

Pursuant to the Reorganisation as fully explained in "History, Development and Reorganisation – Reorganisation" of the Prospectus of the company dated 28 December 2017 (the "**Prospectus**"), the company became the holding company of the companies now comprising the Group on 3 March 2017. The Companies now comprising the Group were under the common control of Mr. Kim Byung Kwon before and after the Reorganisation. Accordingly, the consolidated financial statements has been prepared on the basis by applying the principles of merger accounting as if the Reorganisation has been completed at the beginning of the reporting period.

The unaudited condensed consolidated financial statements of the companies now comprising the Group have been prepared as if the current group structure upon completion of the Reorganisation had been in existence throughout the reporting period or since their respective date of incorporation, where there is a shorter period.

All intra-group transactions and balances have been eliminated on combination.

3. BASIS OF PREPARATION AND ACCOUNTING POLICIES

The Group's unaudited condensed consolidated results for the three months and nine months ended 30 September 2020 have been prepared in accordance with the applicable disclosure requirements set out in Chapter 18 of the GEM Listing Rules and Hong Kong Financial Reporting Standards ("HKFRSs") issued by the Hong Kong Institute of Certified Public Accountants ("HKICPA").

The HKICPA has issued a number of amendments to HKFRSs which are effective for the current accounting period of the Group. None of those developments have had a material effect on how the Group's results and financial position for the current or prior periods have been prepared or presented. The Group has not applied any new standard or interpretation that is not yet effective for the current accounting period.

The accounting policies adopted in preparing the unaudited condensed consolidated financial statements for the three months and nine months ended 30 September 2020 are consistent with those adopted in the financial statements of the Group for the year ended 31 December 2019.

The unaudited condensed consolidated financial statements of the Group for the three months and nine months ended 30 September 2020 have not been audited by the Company's auditors but have been reviewed by the audit committee of the Company.

4. REVENUE

The principal activities of the Group are manufacturing and sales of networking products and non-networking products.

On 21 March 2018, the Hong Kong Legislative Council passed The Inland Revenue (Amendment) (No. 7) Bill 2017 (the “**Bill**”) which introduces the two-tiered profits tax rates regime. The Bill was signed into law on 28 March 2018 and was gazetted on the following day.

Under the two-tiered profits tax rates regime, the first HK\$2 million of assessable profits of qualifying corporations will be taxed at 8.25%, and assessable profits above HK\$2 million will be taxed at 16.5%. The assessable profits of corporations not qualifying for the two-tiered profits tax rates regime will continue to be taxed at a flat rate of 16.5%. The two-tiered profits tax rates regime is applicable to the Group for the period ended 30 September 2020 and 2019. No provision of Profit Tax for subsidiary in Hong Kong has been provided as no assessable profit during the three months and nine months ended 30 September 2020 and 2019.

In 2015, 吉翁電子(深圳)有限公司 was a High and New Technology Enterprise defined by Shenzhen Finance Bureau, Administrator of Local Taxation of Shenzhen Municipality and Shenzhen Municipal office of the State Administration of Taxation (the “**Authority**”) and therefore was entitled to 15% preferential tax rate from PRC enterprise income tax for three years starting from year ended 31 December 2015 and renewed on 16 October 2018, according to the New PRC Enterprise Income Tax Law. No provision of PRC enterprise income tax had been recognised, as no assessable profit for the three months and nine months ended 30 September 2020.

Taiwan Corporate Income Tax is calculated at 17% of the estimated assessable profit for the three months and nine months ended 30 September 2020 and 2019.

Vietnam Corporate Income Tax is calculated at 20% of the estimated assessable profit for the three months and nine months ended 30 September 2020 and 2019. No provision of Profits Tax for the subsidiary in Vietnam as no assessable profit for the three months and nine months ended 30 September 2019.

Malaysia Corporate Income Tax is calculated at 17% for the first MYD500,000 and 24% for MYD500,000 onward of the estimated assessable profit for the period ended 30 September 2020. No provision of Corporate Income Tax for the subsidiary in Malaysia has been recognised as no assessable profit for the year ended 30 September 2020.

No provision for taxation has been recognised for companies incorporated in the Cayman Islands and the BVI as they are not subject to any tax during the three months and nine months ended 30 September 2020 and 2019.

7. DIVIDEND

The Board does not recommend the payment of any dividend for the nine months ended 30 September 2020 (2019: Nil).

The calculation of basic (loss)/earnings per share for the three months and nine months ended 30 September 2020 is calculated by dividing unaudited (loss)/profit attributable to the owners of the Company for the three months and nine months ended 30 September 2020 over the weighted average number of ordinary shares in issue during the three months and nine months ended 30 September 2020.

Diluted earnings per share were same as the basic earnings per share as there were no potential dilutive ordinary shares in existence during the three months and nine months ended 30 September 2020 and 2019.

MANAGEMENT DISCUSSION AND ANALYSIS

BUSINESS REVIEW AND OUTLOOK

Business review

The Group is principally engaged in manufacturing and sales of networking products, specialising in the design and development of wireless networking products which are primarily targeted for home use and small scale commercial applications. The Group also manufactures and sells wired and wireless networking products such as Ethernet switches, LAN cards, Wi-Fi modules and Access Points as well as non-networking products, such as power banks and USB hubs. Its operations are mainly based in the PRC. Its main products are routers, which provide for wired and wireless transmission of data to devices while maintaining wired connection with modems.

On 18 January 2018, the success of listing (the “**Listing**”) of the Company’s shares on GEM of the Stock Exchange was an important milestone for the Group, improving its capital strength and increasing the Group’s resources for market penetration, production capacity and research and development.

The Group sold its branded products mainly on a wholesale basis through its distributors covering many countries and regions including Korea, the PRC, Vietnam, Hong Kong, Taiwan and Malaysia. In addition, the Group has subsidiaries in Taiwan and Vietnam with strong sales team working closely with their distributors. The revenue contributed from the Group’s Taiwan and Vietnam operations were approximately HK\$28.9 million and HK\$23.6 million, respectively, for the nine months ended 30 September 2020, which in aggregate contributed approximately 10.76% of the Group’s revenue. The Group is looking forward to growth in the Asia-Pacific market including Vietnam and Taiwan in the coming years.

Outlook

The Group’s business objective is to strengthen the Group’s position as a networking products manufacturer specialising in the design and development of wireless networking products by enhancing recognition of the Group’s own brand and increasing the Group’s profitability. In support of the Group’s business objective, the Group will continue to implement the business strategies of increasing the Group’s growth in the emerging markets in Asia and other markets with good potential and broadening its product offerings, enhancing the Group’s overall competitiveness and market share.

The current business environment remains overshadowed by the United States and PRC trade tensions and the recent COVID-19 pandemic. The global COVID-19 pandemic constitutes an extraordinary event, a public health risk to all countries through international spread, and continues to require a coordinated international response. The speed of recovery and the extent of any long term impact remain uncertain but will depend on the duration and severity of the crisis and associated containment measures. Despite this, the Group will continue to pursue and maintain a conservative but proactive investment approach, focusing on product innovation, market share gain, geographical expansion and operational excellence, so as to bring better returns for the shareholders and ensure the Company stays competitive in the market.

FINANCIAL REVIEW

For the nine months ended 30 September 2020, the Group recorded revenue of approximately HK\$488.0 million, representing an increase of approximately 3.6% comparing with that of approximately HK\$470.9 million for the nine months ended 30 September 2019.

The decrease was mainly due to the negative impact of the COVID-19 pandemic and restriction on business activities in China and other Asian countries.

Cost of sales and gross profit

During the nine months ended 30 September 2020, the Group's gross profit decreased by approximately 20.1% from approximately HK\$76.1 million for the nine months ended 30 September 2019 to approximately HK\$60.8 million for the nine months ended 30 September 2020. The Group's cost of sales comprises costs of materials, direct labour, manufacturing overhead, subcontracting services fee and other overhead. The cost of sales increase by approximately 8.2% from approximately HK\$394.7 million for the nine months ended 30 September 2019 to approximately HK\$427.1 million for the nine months ended 30 September 2020.

The gross profit margin decreased from approximately 16.2% for the nine months ended 30 September 2019 to approximately 12.5% for the nine months ended 30 September 2020. The decrease of gross profit was due to an increase in production cost such as material costs and direct labour cost for the nine months ended 30 September 2020.

Selling and distribution expenses

Selling and distribution expenses significantly decreased by approximately 25.2% from approximately HK\$15.1 million for the nine months ended 30 September 2019 to approximately HK\$11.3 million for the nine months ended 30 September 2020. The decrease was mainly driven by the decrease in salaries and commission for sales teams, the decline in marketing expenses as well as transportation costs during the current period.

Administrative expenses

Administrative expenses decreased by approximately 11.2% from approximately HK\$37.4 million for the nine months ended 30 September 2019 to approximately HK\$33.2 million for the nine months ended 30 September 2020, which was mainly due to the aggregate decrease of the staff costs and staff welfare expenses.

Research and development expenses

Research and development expenses decreased by approximately 10.7% from approximately HK\$18.7 million for the nine months ended 30 September 2019 to approximately HK\$16.7 million for the nine months ended 30 September 2020. The reason of a decrease is the Group invested at comparably lower level in research and development activities particular in personal related expense for the nine months ended 30 September 2020.

Finance costs

Finance costs increased by approximately 9.7% from approximately HK\$3.1 million for the nine months ended 30 September 2019 to approximately HK\$3.4 million for the nine months ended 30 September 2020. The increase was largely due to the increase in interest expenses on bank borrowings from approximately HK\$2.0 million for the nine months ended 30 September 2019 to approximately HK\$2.7 million for the nine months ended 30 September 2020. Such increase was mainly attribute to new bank borrowings raised by the Group's subsidiary in Vietnam. The increase was partially offset by the decrease of interest expenses on lease liabilities/obligation under finance lease from approximately HK\$1.1 million for the nine months ended 30 September 2019 to approximately HK\$0.7 million for the nine months ended 30 September 2020.

Profit for the period

As a result of the foregoing, the profit for the nine months ended 30 September 2020 amounted to approximately HK\$1.3 million, comparing with the profit of approximately HK\$6.5 million for the nine months ended 30 September 2019.

CONTINGENT LIABILITIES

As at 30 September 2020, the Group did not have any significant contingent liabilities (2019: nil).

PLEDGE OF ASSETS

As at 30 September 2020, bank deposits of approximately HK\$24.4 million (2019: approximately HK\$18.4 million), property, plant and equipment with a carrying value of approximately HK\$89.6 million (2019: approximately HK\$75.9 million), financial assets at fair value through profit or loss with a carrying value of approximately HK\$11.3 million (2019: approximately HK\$22.3 million) of the Group were pledged to secure the Group's bank borrowings. Bank borrowings guaranteed by personal guarantee have been replaced by a corporate guarantee on the Listing Date.

SIGNIFICANT INVESTMENTS HELD

During the nine months ended 30 September 2020, there were financial assets at fair value through profit or loss held by the Group.

FUTURE PLANS FOR MATERIAL INVESTMENTS AND CAPITAL ASSETS

As at the date of this report, the Group did not have any other plans for material investments and capital assets except for those disclosed in the section headed "Future Plan and Use of Proceeds" in the Prospectus and the composite document dated 20 September 2019 in relation to the mandatory unconditional cash offer to acquire all the listed shares of the Company.

MATERIAL ACQUISITIONS AND DISPOSALS OF SUBSIDIARIES AND AFFILIATED COMPANIES

During the nine months ended 30 September 2020, the Group did not have any material acquisitions and disposals of subsidiaries and affiliated companies.

EMPLOYEES INFORMATION

The Group had 1,084 employees (including Directors) as at 30 September 2020 (2019: 903 employees) in Hong Kong, the PRC, Taiwan, Malaysia and Vietnam.

The Group also reviews the performance of the Group's staff periodically and consider the result of such review for staff's annual bonus, salary review and promotion appraisal. The Company has also adopted a share option scheme, details of which are set out in the section headed "Statutory and General Information – D. Share Option Scheme" in Appendix IV to the Prospectus.

USE OF PROCEEDS

As of the date of this report, all of the net proceeds from the Share Offer after deducting underwriting commission and other expenses in relation thereto, amounting to approximately HK\$42.5 million, had been utilised. For more information, please refer to the Company's announcements dated 29 March 2019 and 18 April 2019, and the Company's annual report for the year ended 31 December 2018.

On 1 January 2020, Mr. Ko Ming Tung, Edward resigned as independent non-executive Director leaving only two independent non-executive Directors which did not meet the requirements pursuant to the above Rules. Mr. Lee Tsung Wah, Jonathan was appointed on 31 March 2020 after trading hours to fill the casual vacancy. Mr. Lee is subject to election by the shareholders at the first general meeting after his appointment and was re-elected at the annual general meeting of the Company on 26 June 2020. Please refer to the Company's announcements dated 1 January 2020, 31 March 2020 and 26 June 2020, and circular dated 20 May 2020 for more information.

The primary duties of the Audit Committee are to make recommendations to the Board on the appointment, re-appointment and removal of external auditors, review and supervise the Group's financial reporting process and internal control system and to provide advice and comments to the Board.

The Audit Committee has reviewed the accounting principles and policies adopted by the Group and the unaudited condensed consolidated financial statements of the Group for the three months and nine months ended 30 September 2020 on 13 November 2020 and is of the opinion that such statements complied with applicable standards, the GEM Listing Rules and that adequate disclosure had been made.
