Executive Directors

Mr. Choi Wai Him, aged 47, is the founder of the Group and is presently the Chairman and Managing Director of the Company. He is responsible for corporate planning, business development and overall management of the Group. He has over 16 years of experience in the construction business and property development in Hong Kong, the PRC and Macau. Mr. Choi is a committee member of Wuhan Committee of the Chinese People's Political Consultative Conference.
