Products

Machine woven:

Axminster and Wilton carpets are produced on traditional weaving looms where fully patterned carpets are constructed by the interweaving of the pile yarn together with the warp and weft yarns, resulting in one of the strongest floorcovering products. Updated computer controls allow large pattern repeats with up to 12 colours. Pile yarns of 80%/20% wool/nylon blends or 100% nylon are commonly specified. Particularly suitable for covering large areas with full patterned designs, machine woven carpets offer durability and reasonable costs. Manufactured by NANHAI, CIT & WEIHAI.



Carpet tile:

Utilizing either a machine tufted or a woven carpet fabric, standard sized carpet tiles have a heavy and stable PVC backing allowing the tiles to be laid on the floor in an almost seamless manner. The key advantage of easy storage, transportation, installation and replacement has led to an increasing popularity of this type of floorcovering especially for the commercial office market worldwide. Hand tufted:

The most flexible hand made process using a single needle tufting gun to insert yarn into a canvas backing. Made traditionally with luxurious wool pile yarn, this type of carpets offers design & colour possibilities limited only by the designers' imagination. Machine tufted:

Hundreds of needles insert pile yarns through a lightweight backing, forming loops or tufts of the required length. These are secured with adhesive and backing for added strength. State of the art tufting looms now offer multi-level cut and loop pile textures as well as limited design pattern capabilities. Tufted carpets are primarily used for cost effective domestic and high volume commercial applications. Produced by CIT and WEIHAL.





Needle punched:

Staple synthetic fibers are entangled and needled to form a compressed fabric which is held together by the friction between the fibers. A cost-effective product suitable for low cost floor or wall covering, as well as the automotive industry. Manufactured by CIT.

YARN:

Wool or synthetic fibre spun into yarn in specifications suitable for carpet production. Carpet yarns are typically spun by the woollen system or semiworsted system. Produced by NANHAI, CIT & WEIHAI predominantly for their own carpet production needs.
