#### **Executive Directors**

Mr. Wang Dan Hui (汪丹輝), aged 33, is the Chairman and an Executive Director. He is responsible for the overall planning and management of the Group. Prior to joining the Group in June 1997, Mr. Wang held various management positions in several US based multinational companies in the US and has over four years of experience in corporate management from various sector of business such as investment banking and international trade. Mr. Wang has obtained a bachelor degree in commerce from the University of Shenzhen in the PRC, a bachelor degree in commerce from the City University of New York in the US and a master of business administration degree from Baruch College, City University of New York in the US.

Mr. Wang Hailou (王海樓), aged 52, is the Managing Director and founder of the Group. Mr. Wang is responsible for the overall operational planning of the Group. Mr. Wang has extensive experience in the chemical industry including the manufacturing of anti-corrosive coating for fluid pipelines and industrial-use lubricants. Prior to the establishment of the Group in November 1992, he worked in 大慶石油管理局(Daqing Petroleum Authority) for more than 16 years. Mr. Wang was graduated from 黑龍江省委黨校大專(the Heilongjiang Province Government Institute) in economic management.

Mr. Wu Chieho Joseph (武志厚), aged 42, is an Executive Director. Mr. Wu is responsible for the marketing, business development and public relationship of the Group. Mr. Wu graduated from the National Chengchi University in Taiwan and obtained a masters degree in international business management from the University of Texas, Us in 1984. Prior to joining the Group in June 1997, Mr. Wu has extensive experience in finance, investment and has been the public relationship manager of an international motor vehicles company in Taiwan for over 14 years.

Mr. Ng Ming Wah (吳銘華), aged 50, is an Executive Director. Mr. Ng is responsible for formulation of business strategies and sales co-ordination for the Group. Mr. Ng has over 16 years of experience in the anti-corrosive coating industries and has extensive experience in general management. Before joining the Group in June 1997, Mr. Ng held various senior management positions in various business sectors including transportation and trading in Hong Kong and the PRC responsible for general management strategic planning, logistic, sales and marketing as well as overall operational control. Mr. Ng resigned on 9 January 2002.

#### Independent Non-executive Directors

Mr. Feng Jianming (馮健明), aged 65, is an Independent Non-executive Director. He is also a professor-grade senior engineer as recognised by CNPC and a consultant of 高技術諮詢中心(High-Technology Consultation Centre). Mr. Ma Wing Yun Bryan (馬榮欣), aged 37, is an Independent Non-executive Director. Mr. Ma is the financial controller of a PRC company which is associated with a listed company in Hong kong and has more than 10 years of experience in financial management and operational management. Mr. Ma is a fellow member of The Association of Chartered Certified Accountants and an associate member of the Hong Kong Society of Accountants. Mr. Ma was appointed as Independent Non-executive Director in February 2001.

Mr. Meng Fanxi (孟凡璽), aged 63, is an Independent Non-executive Director. Mr. Meng is currently engaged in the consultancy business of corporate management. Mr. Meng was a director and the deputy general manager of China International Trust Investment Corporation from 1990 to 2000 and he was responsible for the corporate planning and import and export business. Before joining China International Trust Investment Corporation in 1985, he was the chief of 中國物資部油品局(Oil Product Bureau of Ministry of Material Supply of the PRC) and was responsible for sales activities of oil products. Mr. Meng graduated from ShanDong Province Metallurgy Institute in metallurgy. Mr. Meng was appointed as Independent Non-executive Director in February 2001.

#### SENIOR MANAGEMENT

Professor Jiang Yingbo (姜英波), aged 77, is the head of anti corrosive coating division and the principal consultant of the research and development department of the Group responsible for the strategic planning of the research and development of the Group. Professor Jiang graduated from上海大眾大學(Shanghai Public University) (presently the Shanghai University of Transport) in 1948 and is, and has been a member of 上海市全國人民大會代表(the National People's Congress of Shanghai City) over the past ten years. Professor Jiang was the chief engineer of 上海開林製漆廠(Shanghai Kailin Paint Manufacturing Company) and he is also a member of 中國防腐科學協會造船協會 (China Anti-corrosion Science Association). In July 1991, Professor Jiang was awarded a certificate of 發展我國工程技術事業做出的突出貢獻(Outstanding contribution to national engineering technology in the PRC) by 中華人民共和國國務院(State Council of the PRC). Professor Jiang joined the Group in June 1993.

Mr. Li Xiao Hua (李曉華), aged 55, is the financial controller of the Group. Mr. Li joined the Group in July and is responsible for the financial management functions of the Group. Mr. Li is well experienced in account and finance. He has been the head of Taxation Bureau of Daqing Municipality Development Zone in Heilongjiang Province and the head of Taxation Audit Bureau of Daqing Municipality in Heilongjiang Province before joining the Group.

Mr. Fei graduated from 黑龍江省委黨校大專 (Heilongjiang Province government Institute) in economic management and has more than 10 years experience in various petroleum refinery related companies in the PRC. Mr. Fei joined the Group in December 1992.

Mr. Zhang Deyu (張德有), aged 58, is the head of lubricants division and the chief senior engineer of the Group. Mr. Zhang is a senior engineer who graduated from the department of chemical engineering of 大慶石油學院 (Daqing Petroleum Institute) with a diploma in petroleum refinery. Mr. Zhang has attained the award of 國家科技成果完成者 (Technology Achievement Award) for 中華人民共和國國家科技術委員會 (Science and Technology Committee of the PRC). ## SENIOR MANAGEMENT REMUNERATION SYSTEM

The remuneration system of the senior management of the Group is a combination of the economic benefit of the senior management (including executive director) and the operation result and share performance of the Group. Most of the senior management have signed result examination contract with the Company. In this system, the remuneration of the senior management comprises three parts, including basic salary, bonus and share options. The floating remuneration of the senior management represents approximately 70% to 75% of their total potential remuneration, which includes result bonus and share option represent approximately 15% to 25% and 50% to 60% respectively of the total potential remuneration. Floating remuneration is linked with the specific business performance indicators, for example, the net profit, capital return and cost reduction indicator.
