This glossary contains explanation of certain technical terms used in this prospectus in connection with the Group and its business. The terms and their meanings may not correspond to the standard definitions within the industry or usage of these terms.

“CCEE”	Certificate of Conformity for Electrical Equipment 電工產品認證合格證書
“GS”	Geprüfte Sicherheit 德國技術監督協會, a German alternate current electrical appliances safety standard certified by TÜV Rheinl Product Safty GmbH
“ISO”	the International Organisation for Standardisation, a worldwide federation of national standards bodies
“ISO 9000 series”	series of international standards on quality management and quality assurance developed by ISO Technical Committee 176 in 1987, which has been adopted by more than 30 countries, including the United Kingdom, the U.S. and most of the European countries, as their national quality system standard
“ISO 9002”	constituent part of the ISO9000 series which covers the areas of management responsibility; quality system; contract review; document and data control; purchasing; control of customer-supplied product; product identification and traceability; process control; inspection and testing; control of inspection, measuring and test equipment; inspection and test status; control of nonconforming product; corrective and preventive action; handling, storage, packaging, preservation and delivery; control of quality records; internal quality audits, training; servicing and statistical techniques
“ODM”	original design manufacturing whereby the manufacturers own the design of the products and the products are marketed under brand names designated by customers
“OEM”	original equipment manufacturing whereby products are manufactured in whole or in part in accordance with the customer’s specifications and are marketed under brand names designated by customers
“SAA”	an Australia alternate current electrical appliances safety standard certified by Standards Association Australia
“UL”	a U.S. alternate current electrical appliances safety standard certified by Underwriters Laboratories, Inc.
“WTO”	World Trade Organisation
