
Social Responsibility Report

The Open University of Hong Kong

Opening the opportunity of education to young people give them the hope to strive and to succeed. This is the reason why we supported The Open University of Hong Kong in its campus development project to provide more learning facilities for their full-time students. For the past 17 years, the university has been playing a dominant role in opening the doors of higher education for young school leavers or working adults.



Kingsway pledged a donation of HK\$1 million for the upcoming three years to support the university as we share their belief that education is for all. We donated HK\$300.000 as the first instalment for this Financial Year.

International Christian School

The mission of the International Christian School is to provide quality education that builds children's character as well as their academic achievement. The project is more than the construction of a traditional school as it includes also a community centre integral to learning.
