This statement is made at the request of The Stock Exchange of Hong Kong Limited (the "Stock Exchange").

The directors of the Company (the "Directors" or the "Board") have noted the recent increases in the price and trading volume of the shares of the Company and wish to state that, save for the transaction described in this announcement, they are not aware of any reasons for such increases. The Directors also confirm that there are no other negotiations or agreements relating to intended acquisitions or realisations which are discloseable under rule 13.23 of the Rules Governing the Listing of Securities on the Stock Exchange (the "Listing Rules"), neither is the Board aware of any matter discloseable under the general obligation imposed by rule 13.09 of the Listing Rules, which is or may be of a price-sensitive nature.

On 12 June 2007, a conditional agreement was entered between a jointly controlled entity of the Company (as the vendor) with an independent third party (as the purchaser) in respect of the disposal of the entire issued share capital of SBI E2-Capital Asia Securities Limited ("SEASL") at a total consideration of HK\$76.76 million. SEASL and its subsidiaries are principally engaged in securities and futures trading.
