

Major Events of the Year 2008



January

- 1** 1,800 staff participated in the 2008 Annual Dinner.
- A love and care team with over 400 staff of the Group was organized to join the Community Chest Walks for Millions on Hong Kong Island.

- The Group was awarded Environmental Merit Award 2007 by Hong Kong Construction Association.
- “Technology Study and System Application of Major Construction Works in Hong Kong Disneyland” was awarded the second prize of the National Science and Technology Progress Award 2007. The Group became the only corporation awarded.
