**In the First Four Months of 2026,
Net Generation of Subsidiary Power Plants Increased by 14.9%,
among which Subsidiary Wind Farms Decreased by 2.1%,
Photovoltaic Plants Increased by 45.3%**

Total net generation of subsidiary power plants in April 2026 increased by 10.9% year on year to 20,335,685 MWh, among which, subsidiary wind farms decreased by 2.6% year on year to 5,028,671 MWh due to the decrease in wind speed, subsidiary photovoltaic plants increased by 46.7% year on year to 1,579,186 MWh.

Total net generation of subsidiary power plants for the first four months of 2026 increased by 14.9% year on year to 80,973,109 MWh, among which, subsidiary wind farms decreased by 2.1% year on year to 19,031,369 MWh due to the decrease in wind speed, subsidiary photovoltaic power plants increased by 45.3% year on year to 5,000,708 MWh.
